Last Game: Friday, Jan. 22 – New Orleans 96, Minnesota 94

Chris Paul registered 23 points and nine assists, and James Posey scored the game-winning layup as time expired in New Orleans' 96-94 victory over the Timberwolves on Friday night at Target Center. Paul tallied 11 points and five assists in the opening quarter as the Hornets went in front 26-24, but a late basket from Jonny Flynn pulled Minnesota even at 53-53 entering halftime. After Corey Brewer sank a 3-pointer to give the Wolves a 63-60 lead midway through the third, New Orleans held them without a basket for the next four minutes and Marcus Thornton's jumper staked the Hornets to a slim 74-71 lead after three. Thornton then keyed a 9-0 blitz that gave New Orleans its largest lead of the night at 83-73 with 8:27 left. Al Jefferson started Minnesota's comeback effort, and a Brewer jumper narrowed the gap to 90-89 at the 2:26 mark. Flynn converted a three-point play with 3.5 seconds left to tie the score at 94-94, setting the stage for Posey's buzzer-beating heroics. Jefferson led Minnesota with 25 points and 13 rebounds, while Flynn scored 20 points and Kevin Love returned from a two-game absence to add 13 points and nine boards.

Previous Game: Wednesday, Jan. 20 – Oklahoma City 94, Minnesota 92

Kevin Durant scored 31 points -- his 13th 30+ effort in 16 games -- and Oklahoma City surpassed last season's victory total with a 94-92 win over the Timberwolves on Wednesday night at Target Center. The first quarter featured six lead changes, ending in a 24-24 deadlock following Wayne Ellington's last-second jumper. Ryan Gomes converted a three-point play to put Minnesota in front with 2:21 left in the second, but Durant's 3-pointer ignited a 9-0 response that lifted the Thunder into a 55-51 halftime lead. Corey Brewer and Damien Wilkins combined to score the Wolves' first 12 points of the second half before Minnesota went silent for the next six minutes and Oklahoma City rattled off 15 unanswered points. Eric Maynor's trey extended the margin to 77-65, but the Wolves rallied ahead 84-83 on a Jonny Flynn jumper with 4:51 left. However, Durant capped a pivotal 11-2 burst that put the Thunder in front to stay, and Minnesota missed two chances to tie in the final minute before Flynn's 3-pointer was off the mark as time expired. Brewer led the Wolves with 25 points and five steals, while Al Jefferson collected 20 points and nine rebounds.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE DUO: Wolves center Al Jefferson hauled down a franchise-record 26 rebounds in the triple-OT loss at Houston on Jan. 13, part of his fifth career 20/20 effort. His 23 defensive rebounds are the most by any NBA player since Kevin Garnett grabbed 23 for Minnesota vs. Orlando on Jan. 12, 2005. Jefferson also becomes just the ninth player in the past 15 years to collect 25+ points and 25+ rebounds in the same game. Meanwhile, forward Kevin Love claimed 13 rebounds at Houston, the 20th time in 24 games this season he's reached double figures (including 17 point/rebound double-doubles):

WOLF TRACKS: New Orleans picked up its second buzzer-beating Target Center win of the season with Friday's 96-94 victory; the Hornets also slipped past Minnesota 97-96 on Dec. 9, and have beaten the Wolves five straight times overall (by a total of 17 points)... The loss drops Minnesota to 2-6 in one-possession games (decided by three points or less); they finished 6-8 in that category a year ago... Oklahoma City notched its 24th win of the season (surpassing its final 2008-09 total) with Wednesday's 94-92 win... Minnesota opened the three-game homestand by snapping its four-game losing streak with a come-from-behind 108-103 OT win over Philadelphia on Monday; the Wolves have now won 13 of their last 15 MLK Day contests, a stretch that began with the 1995 victory over Houston... Monday's outing was Minnesota's second OT game in six days and 100th all-time (44 wins, 56 losses)... Memphis beat the Wolves for the third time this season with last Friday's 135-110 verdict... The Grizzlies' 135 points represent the third-highest total ever allowed by the Wolves; Golden State has scored 146 on two separate occasions (Nov. 9, 2009 and Apr. 1, 1994)... Last Friday's defeat marked the 10th time this season the Wolves have permitted 120+ points and their ninth loss by 20+ points; a year ago, Minnesota allowed 120 points on four occasions and suffered 10 losses by 20+... Houston beat the Wolves 120-114 on Jan. 13, the first triple-overtime game in club history... Minnesota suffered a 105-94 defeat at Denver on Jan. 11; they'd handed the Nuggets a 106-100 loss in their first trip to the Pepsi Center this season (Nov. 29)... Minnesota began the four-game road trip with a 110-96 loss in Chicago on Jan. 9; they ended a five-game losing streak with the 116-109 victory over Indiana one night earlier, avenging a 122-111 loss to the Pacers on Jan. 2 at Conseco Fieldhouse... The Wolves tallied a season-high 116 points vs. Indiana; they've cracked the Century Mark in 13 of their past 21 starts, after clearing 100 in just five of their first 23 outings... Meanwhile, the Wolves had given up 100+ points in 11 consecutive starts (allowing an average of 112.8 ppg) before limiting Oklahoma City to 94 on Wednesday...

SCHEDULE NOTES: Tonight's contest opens a three-game road trip for the Wolves; they'll visit New York on Tuesday and Cleveland on Wednesday, winding down a 10-game stretch that features seven away from Target Center... Minnesota has dropped six straight road games since beating New Jersey 103-99 on Dec. 23... Tonight's game also wraps up the 11th of 20 sets of back-to-back outings for 2009-10; they're 2-8 on the tail end of back-to-backs, beating Utah (Dec. 5) and New Jersey (Dec. 23), having finished 6-16 a year ago... The Jan. 2 game at Indiana concluded the Wolves' second four-games-in-five-nights set this year; Minnesota has three such groupings slated in 2009-10, up from one a year ago... The Wolves have won five of their last eight vs. sub-.500 foes; on the flipside, Friday's loss to Oklahoma City was their 10th in a row vs. teams with winning records, dating to the 110-108 win at Utah on Dec. 14...

ALL YOU NEED IS...: Minnesota collected 65 rebounds in the triple-OT game at Houston on Jan. 15, tying the club single-game record set vs. Philadelphia on Feb. 3, 1991 (double-OT)... The Wolves outboarded Indiana 56-36 on Jan. 8, their seventh double-digit margin of the season; they piled up a 49-29 edge Dec. 9 vs. New Orleans... Minnesota has held the board edge in 18 of its past 28 starts, compiling a +3.8 rpg (46.0-42.2) margin in that span; the Wolves had come up short in nine of their previous 11 appearances... Phoenix outrebounded Minnesota 45-35 on Nov. 27, the seventh time they've faced a double-digit deficit... The Wolves have climbed to 9th in the NBA in offensive rebound percentage (.280) and 8th in total rebound percentage (.511), after sitting just 18th and 25th, respectively, in late November... NO FREE LUNCH: The Wolves finished 33-for-45 from the line Jan. 8 vs. Indiana, their busiest night in nearly four years (since a 40-for-51 outing vs. New York on Mar. 26, 2006) and just the third time in 10 years they've attempted 45+... Minnesota has boosted its frequency to 26.6 attempts per game over its past 21 games, after averaging just 20.0 in its first 23 starts... Toronto's 40-for-48 effort on Dec. 8 marks the most prolific night by a Wolves opponent in nearly 10 years (since Phoenix went 43-for-49 on Mar. 14, 2000) and just the 9th time an opponent has converted 40+ FTs... Minnesota sank all 18 of its FT attempts Nov. 21 at Portland, the 17th perfect night in franchise annals; the club record for most FTs made without a miss is 24 (at Phoenix, Apr. 5, 2003)... They rank 20th in FT accuracy (74.6%) and 25th in FTs attempted (23.2 per game); a year ago, Minnesota ended 15th (76.9%) and 19th (23.9 per game)...

FINDING THE RANGE: Minnesota shot 57.1% in the Dec. 5 win over Utah, their highest percentage since hitting 59.0% vs. Phoenix on Jan. 29, 2007 (a 121-112 win)... The Wolves have cleared 50% in seven of their past 28 starts, most recently a 50.0% effort in the Jan. 8 win over Indiana; they'd hit 50%+ just once in their first 16 outings (52.0% vs. Boston, Nov. 2)... A year ago, Minnesota put together back-to-back 50%+ nights twice; the last time they topped that mark in three straight games was Mar. 14-15-17, 2008... The Wolves shot a season-low 32.6% vs. Dallas on Nov. 13, one of nine sub-40% outings to date; a year ago, they finished below 40% on 11 occasions, going 0-11... The 37.4% effort vs. Washington on Dec. 26 marked the first time Minnesota has won when shooting below 40% since Mar. 19, 2008 vs. Memphis... The Wolves currently stand 25th in FG accuracy (44.2%) and 25th in scoring (96.9 ppg)...

LONG-RANGE PLANS: Indiana finished 16-for-32 from beyond the arc on Jan. 8, equaling the 2nd-highest total of three-pointers ever allowed by Minnesota (franchise record: 17 by Golden State, Apr. 12, 1995); Orlando hit 15-for-37 on New Year's Day... For their part, the Wolves sank a season-high eight treys (in 18 attempts) vs. Orlando, and are shooting 35.4% (68-for-192) in their past 14 starts... Minnesota has surrendered 10+ three-pointers on 16 occasions (including Memphis' 11-for-23 effort on Jan. 15), allowing a league-high average of 7.68 per night; Toronto (7.25) is second... They're allowing a combined 36.9% (good for 26th), including 40.7% (149-for-366) over the last 18... Meanwhile, the Wolves stand 28th in three-point accuracy (30.9%) and 28th in treys made (3.98 per game)...

ONE FOR THE BOOKS: Golden State's 146-point explosion on Nov. 9 equaled the top single-game total ever by a Wolves opponent; the Warriors posted a 146-109 victory on Apr. 1, 1994 in Oakland... The final 41-point spread also matches the biggest losing margin in club history; Minnesota suffered a 113-72 defeat at Miami on Mar. 5, 1996... The Wolves committed 28 turnovers at Golden State, one short of the franchise single-game record; they coughed it up 29 times at New Jersey on Nov. 4, 2002... Meanwhile, the Warriors' 22 steals on Nov. 9 mark the highest total in an NBA game in over 12 years, since Atlanta swiped 23 at Philadelphia on Apr. 9, 1997...
