**Last Game: Friday, Mar. 14 – Charlotte 105, Minnesota 93**

Al Jefferson tallied 25 points and 16 rebounds, and Gary Neal keyed a second-quarter blitz as Charlotte extended its home winning streak to eight games with a 105-93 victory over the Timberwolves on Friday night at Time Warner Cable Arena. Dante Cunningham gave Minnesota its largest lead at 33-28 late in the first quarter, but Neal's three-point play triggered a 31-10 onslaught over the next nine minutes that put the Bobcats in control. Neal scored 14 points during the run, which culminated in Cody Zeller's dunk at the 3:55 mark to make it 59-43. A last-second basket by Nikola Pekovic got the Wolves to within 65-53 at halftime, but Minnesota opened the third quarter 0-for-5 from the floor while Jefferson poured in 13 points in a five-minute span for Charlotte. The margin crested at 88-70 on another Zeller dunk with 1:21 left in the period, before the Wolves rallied to within 10 on a Chase Budinger trey with 8:06 to play in the contest. However, Neal countered with a long-range strike of his own and Minnesota could get no closer the rest of the way. Neal finished with 19 points for the Bobcats while Kevin Martin's 19 points topped Minnesota.

**Previous Game: Tuesday, Mar. 11 – Minnesota 112, Milwaukee 101**

Kevin Love scored 27 points and Kevin Martin added 26 as the Timberwolves spotted Milwaukee an early 11-point lead before rallying to win, 112-101, on Tuesday night at Target Center. The Bucks sank their first 12 shots in building a 24-16 cushion and expanded that to 33-22 on Ramon Sessions' 3-pointer late in the opening period. J.J. Barea capped a 12-2 push that put Minnesota on top briefly in the second before Milwaukee reclaimed a 61-55 halftime advantage and went up by 10 on John Henson's basket early in the third quarter. Back-to-back treys from Martin and Ricky Rubio started the Wolves' comeback and Minnesota built a six-point lead before late jumpers by Nate Wolters and Jeff Adrien pulled Milwaukee to within 86-84 entering the fourth. However, Minnesota limited the Bucks to just one field goal in the next seven minutes and consecutive Nikola Pekovic layups capped an 18-3 blitz that gave the Wolves a 105-88 lead with 5:07 remaining. Barea finished with 19 points and Rubio dealt 10 assists for Minnesota. Brandon Knight led the Bucks with 21 points while Zaza Pachulia handed out a career-high 10 assists.

**Second Meeting:** Kevin Martin scored 13 of his 27 points in the fourth quarter to help the Wolves snap a three-game losing streak by holding off Dallas, 112-106, on Nov. 30 at American Airlines Center. **TRIPLE LINDY:** Kevin Love registered his first career triple-double in the Feb. 22 victory at Utah, becoming the 10th player in Wolves history to accomplish that feat. Love went 6-for-10 from beyond the arc, making him one of only eight NBA players in the past 30 years to collect 30+ points, 10+ rebounds, 10+ assists and 5+ three-pointers in a single game. **LOVE WEEK'S BEST IN WEST:** On Feb. 24, Timberwolves forward Kevin Love was named the NBA's Western Conference Player of the Week for games played Feb. 18-23. Love led Minnesota to a 2-1 record for the week, averaging a league-best 36.7 ppg, 12.7 rpg and 3.7 apg while shooting 57.1% from the floor, 46.4% from three-point range and 86.2% from the FT line. He tallied 42 points and 16 rebounds in the 104-91 win over Indiana on Feb. 19, his fourth 40+ effort of the season and club-record eighth in a Wolves uniform. He followed up with the first triple-double of his career (37 points, 12 rebounds, career-high 10 assists) as Minnesota won 121-104 at Utah on Feb. 22, then capped the week with 31 points and 10 rebounds at Portland on Feb. 23. It's the second weekly honor of Love's career, having also won on Nov. 4; he's one of six players in Wolves history to win the award, joining Kevin Garnett (15 times), Al Jefferson (twice), Stephon Marbury (Feb. 21, 1999), Sam Cassell (Dec. 28, 2003) and Nikola Pekovic (Apr. 8, 2013).

**BREWER'S BLEND:** Corey Brewer currently ranks 7th in the NBA in fast break scoring by tallying 4.9 ppg in that category. Meanwhile, Nikola Pekovic (5.4 ppg) and Kevin Love (4.5 ppg) rank 1-3 in second-chance scoring, and Pekovic stands 3rd on league leader board for points in the paint (13.4 ppg). **WOLF TRACKS:** Charlotte earned a split of its two-game season set vs. the Wolves with Friday's 105-93 decision, avenging a 119-92 loss at Target Center on Jan. 10... At 32-32, the Wolves are six games back of 8th-place Memphis (39-27) and Dallas (39-27) in the West playoff race... Minnesota completed a 2-2 homestand by beating Milwaukee 112-101 on Tuesday... Toronto beat the Wolves for the 18th time in 19 meetings with last Sunday's 111-104 decision; two nights earlier, Minnesota notched a 114-101 win over Detroit... The homestand began with a 118-106 loss to New York on Mar. 5, halting the Wolves' three-game winning streak... Minnesota completed a 4-1 West Coast trip with the 132-128 win at Denver on Mar. 3... It's the sixth time in club history they've won four games on a single road trip, the first since December 2005... The Wolves began with a 121-104 win at Utah on Feb. 22 before suffering a 108-97 loss the following night in Portland... Minnesota spotted Phoenix an 81-75 lead entering the fourth quarter on Feb. 25 before rallying to win 110-101, just their third victory this year when trailing after three... Minnesota returned from the All-Star Break with a 104-91 win over Indiana on Feb. 19... The Wolves halted their season-high four-game losing streak with the 117-90 rout of Denver on Feb. 12... The skid began with a 106-97 setback at Oklahoma City on Feb. 5 and included losses at New Orleans, vs. Portland and vs. Houston...

**THE NOISE IS WORKING:** The Wolves wrapped up a five-game road trip Mar. 3 in Denver; starting Mar. 5 vs. New York, they're now in a four-week stretch that sees them play 10 of 15 at home... However, beginning with the Dec. 28 win at Milwaukee, the Wolves have gone 9-8 on the road but just 9-9 at Target Center... Friday's game capped a run of five straight games vs. Eastern foes; they're 15-10 overall vs. the East, including 10-3 at home... The Feb. 23 loss in Portland completed the 15th of 21 back-to-back sets for the Wolves in 2013-14; they're 10-5 in the openers and 4-11 on the tail ends of back-to-backs thus far... The Feb. 8 game vs. Portland capped the second of two four-games-in-five-nights grinds for Minnesota (also Nov. 19-23)... Starting with the Mar. 1 game in Sacramento, seven of their first eight games in March are vs. sub-.500 opponents (concluding with tonight's visit from the Kings)... However, beginning Wednesday in Dallas, 12 of Minnesota's final 16 contests will be against teams currently sporting winning records...

**THREES & FREES:** The Wolves' 52-for-64 effort Mar. 3 at Denver shattered the franchise single-game records for FTs made and attempted... Minnesota is 3rd by averaging 27.8 FTAs per night; they're also 2nd in the league in FTs made per game (21.6), 7th in FT accuracy (77.7%) and 3rd in fouls drawn (23.6 per game)... At the other end, Minnesota's opponents are attempting just 19.7 FTs per night, the 12th-lowest single-season average in NBA history... The Wolves went 16-for-26 from long range Jan. 6 at Philadelphia, a season high for makes; Minnesota is 23-12 when hitting 7+ treys... They've climbed to 38.9% (21-for-54) over their past three starts, after shooting at just a 28.1% clip (36-for-128) in the previous six... The Wolves rank 17th in three-pointers made (7.4 per game) but 26th in three-point accuracy (34.1%)... At the other end, San Antonio's 9-for-13 (69.2%) effort Jan. 12 is a season high percentage vs. Minnesota; they've allowed 39.3% (77-for-196) from long range in the last nine, after giving up 32.2% in the previous five...

**OFF TARGET:** Utah's 28.8% outing on Jan. 18 marks the 2nd-lowest percentage ever by a Wolves opponent (Toronto shot 27.5% on Nov. 1, 2003)... Minnesota hit a season-high 55.7% on Jan. 1 vs. New Orleans, the first of three 50%+ nights in January (seven total); they shot 52.3% vs. Denver on Feb. 12, ending a drought of 10 consecutive games below 50% accuracy... The Wolves have won nine in a row (7-0 this season) and 19 of their last 20 when shooting 50%+; including Denver's 39.3% outing on Feb. 12, Minnesota has also now won its last 19 starts when holding the opponent below 40%... Minnesota finished at 29.3% in the Dec. 7 loss to Miami, the lowest single-game percentage in franchise history... Overall, the Wolves rank 25th in the NBA at 44.0% but are 5th in scoring (106.1 ppg); the club single-season record for scoring average is 101.1 ppg, set in 1997-98... At the other end, San Antonio's 56.8% effort on Jan. 12 marks the top percentage by a Wolves opponent this year; Minnesota has permitted 50%+ accuracy 17 times overall, going 5-12...

**THE BOARD REPORT:** Charlotte posted a 54-35 edge on Friday, the largest margin the Wolves have faced this year; they've come up short in 13 of the past 22 games... That stretch began with a 50-40 deficit at Portland on Jan. 25; before that contest, Minnesota had been outboarded in just seven of its previous 37 starts... The Wolves outrebounded Utah 49-34 on Feb. 22, their 3rd-biggest margin of the season and seventh double-digit spread overall; they were on the short end of a 48-38 count Mar. 9 vs. Toronto... Oklahoma City posted a 45-40 advantage on Jan. 4, the first time Minnesota had fallen short at home since Nov. 6 vs. Golden State... Still, the Wolves rank 8th in total rebound pct (.515), 6th in offensive rebound pct (.277) and 12th in defensive rebound pct (.753)... They've compiled a +1.3 rpg advantage for the year (45.3-44.0), but are being outboarded by -1.2 rpg (43.8-45.0) in the past 22 contests...

**THIEVERY CORPORATION:** Minnesota tallied 30 points off 15 Bucks TOs on Tuesday, the third time this year they've scored 30+ (season best is 37 at Houston on Nov. 23)... The season-high 16-steal effort Jan. 12 at San Antonio is one of 24 times the Wolves have reached double digits; they had 29 such games a year ago, which was their top total since 2000-01... Ricky Rubio and Corey Brewer have combined for 263 steals, the most-prolific duo in the NBA this year (Thaddeus Young/Michael Carter-Williams are 2nd with 237)... Philly's 26 TOs on Dec. 11 are the most the Wolves have forced this season and one of 17 times they've generated 20+... The Wolves committed a season-low five TOs Dec. 27 vs. Washington; they've cut their TOs to 11.4 per game in seven March starts, including a seven-TO night Tuesday vs. Milwaukee... Minnesota ranks 4th in fewest TOs (13.6 per game) and 4th in TOs forced (16.3)...

**MARGINAL INFORMATION:** Minnesota's 88 points vs. New Orleans on Jan. 29 are the fewest they've scored in a victory this season and mark just the second time they've won in the past 30 when tallying fewer than 90... The Wolves claimed a 121-120 victory at Golden State on Jan. 24 -- their first this season in a game decided by four points or less, snapping a 14-game losing streak in that category; they're now 2-12 on the season when the final margin is four or less... The Wolves have won three times when being held below 100; the 98-72 victory over Utah on Jan. 18 halted an 18-game losing streak in that category (0-10 this year)... Minnesota recorded its club-record-tying 10th 20-point victory with the Feb. 12 decision vs. Denver; the Wolves have now built leads of 30+ points in 12 of their 64 games to date (a league high), the top single-season total in the NBA since Utah had 14 such games in 1996-97... Minnesota posted a 126-95 win at Philadelphia on Jan. 6; the 31-point spread equals the 2nd-largest road win in club history...

**WOLF TRACKS:** Minnesota ended 2012-13 with a 31-51 record, its highest victory total since finishing 32-50 in 2006-07; this year's winning percentage (.378) fell short of the .394 (26-40) mark the Wolves compiled a season ago... Minnesota's season was highlighted by two wins apiece vs. San Antonio, Oklahoma City and Denver, the Western Conference's top three teams record-wise... Minnesota has now missed the postseason in nine straight seasons, after advancing to the playoffs every year from 1996-97 through 2003-04 (eight)... The current absence is the longest active postseason drought; Sacramento (seven), Toronto (five) and Washington (five) are next on that list... The Wolves began the season 16-15 (through Jan. 8), then endured a 7-28 stretch (Jan. 9-Mar. 21) before splitting their final 16 contests... The 107-101 home win over Detroit on Apr. 6 marked Rick Adelman's 1000th victory as an NBA head coach... Minnesota closed with four wins in its final seven away from Target Center, including a season-high three-game road winning streak (Mar. 22-26-Apr. 3)... The wins at Detroit (105-82 on Mar. 26) and Phoenix (117-86 on Mar. 22) marked the first time in club history that the Wolves have registered 20-point victories in consecutive road games... The final 31-point spread at Phoenix equals the second-largest road win in franchise history (and ties the 10th-largest overall); they won by 35 at Philadelphia (119-84) on Dec. 8, 2004... Prior to the three-game road winning streak, Minnesota had suffered through an 11-week stretch that saw them drop 17 of 18 road games; the Feb. 11 victory at Cleveland bisected droughts of eight (Jan. 9-Feb. 10) and nine games (Feb. 22-Mar. 21)... Memphis pulled away for a 99-86 win on Mar. 30 at Target Center... Minnesota took a 67-65 lead into the fourth period before being outscored 34-19 by the Grizzlies; they dropped 13 games when leading after three (second behind Cleveland's 14) and lost 18 games after building leads of 10+ points... Houston spotted the Wolves a 20-point, 3rd-quarter cushion before rallying to win 108-100 on Mar. 15; it's the biggest lead Minnesota let slip away this year and the 13th time in franchise history they've lost after building a lead of 20+ points...

**SCHEDULE NOTES:** Minnesota enjoyed a 5-5 final month, after compiling a 1-26 record over its previous three Aprils... The Apr. 17 triumph at San Antonio marked the Wolves' first victory in a season finale in five years (110-101 OT vs. Milwaukee, Apr. 16, 2008), and also halted a 16-game losing streak at the AT&T Center that dated to January 2004... Minnesota faced four groupings of four-games-in-five-nights this season, including three in the final five weeks (Mar. 9-13, Mar. 26-30, Apr. 9-13)... The Mar. 30 game vs. Memphis completed Minnesota's second seven-games-in-10-nights run in March (Mar. 9-18, Mar. 21-30); they went 8-14 on the tail end of back-to-back sets this season, after going 5-15 in those situations a year ago... The Wolves finished 20-21 for their best home record since going 20-21 in 2006-07... Minnesota drew an SRO 20,340 vs. Houston on Dec. 26, the third-largest crowd in Target Center history...

Minnesota is his fifth stop in an NBA coaching career that began in 1983 as an assistant to Jack Ramsay with Portland... Became the Trail Blazers' head coach on Feb. 18, 1989; he led them to the NBA Finals twice in his five full seasons on the bench (1990 and 1992) and won a career-best 63 games in 1990-91... Spent two seasons (1995-96 and 1996-97) with the Golden State Warriors before moving on to Sacramento in 1998... Took the Kings to the NBA Playoffs in each of his eight seasons there, including a trip to the Western Conference Finals in 2002; he compiled a 395-229 record (.633) to become the winningest coach in franchise history... Most recently, he coached the past four seasons (2007-08 through 2010-11) in Houston, a stint highlighted by a 22-game winning streak (Jan. 29-Mar. 16, 2008) that's the second-longest in NBA history... *Became the eighth coach in NBA history to reach the 1000-victory mark with the Apr. 6, 2013 win over Detroit*; he now leads all active coaches in wins... Has also compiled a 79-78 postseason record; his teams have qualified for the playoffs 16 times in his 22 seasons as a head coach... Has been runner-up for NBA Coach of the Year honors four times (1990-91, 2000-01, 2001-02 and 2008-09), and has coached the West team in the NBA All-Star Game on three occasions (1991, 2001, 2003)... Appeared in 462 games during his seven-year NBA career, beginning in 1968-69 with the San Diego Rockets; he also played for Portland, Chicago, the New Orleans Jazz and the Kansas City-Omaha Kings...
