**Last Game: Wednesday, Mar. 26 – Minnesota 107, Atlanta 83**

Gorgui Dieng picked up his fifth double-double (15 points, 15 rebounds) in six games as the Timberwolves snapped a three-game losing streak by routing Atlanta, 107-83, on Wednesday night at Target Center. Corey Brewer beat the first-quarter buzzer to provide Minnesota with a 20-19 lead that they never relinquished. Chase Budinger ignited an 8-0 spurt that pushed the Wolves' advantage to 11 midway through the second, and after Mike Scott's 3-pointer pulled the Hawks to within five, Brewer again scored as time expired to send Minnesota into halftime with a 48-41 lead. Back-to-back dunks from Brewer and Kevin Love highlighted a 14-4 burst that put the Wolves on top 74-57 late in the third period, and Atlanta could get no closer than 14 the rest of the way. Treys by J.J. Barea and Budinger bookended an 11-0 uprising that gave Minnesota its largest lead of the night at 99-71 with 4:23 remaining and the Wolves went on to beat the Hawks for just the second time in their past 15 meetings. Brewer and Kevin Martin finished with 18 points apiece for Minnesota while Ricky Rubio contributed 10 assists and six steals. Scott's 15 points topped Atlanta.

**Previous Game: Monday, Mar. 24 – Memphis 109, Minnesota 92**

Mike Conley's 23 points led six double-figure scorers as Memphis extended its home winning streak to 10 games by rolling past the Timberwolves, 109-92, on Monday night at the FedExForum. The Grizzlies never trailed, building a 30-15 lead after one quarter by limiting Minnesota to 21 percent shooting. The margin reached 21 midway through the second before Alexey Shved's 3-pointer triggered a 9-0 rally that brought the Wolves to within 45-35. Back-to-back dunks from Tayshaun Prince and Marc Gasol rebuilt Memphis' lead to 57-39 at halftime, but Minnesota opened the third quarter by hitting its first five shots to once again shave the deficit to 10. However, Zach Randolph countered with seven unanswered points and Conley's trey topped off the 18-4 barrage that pushed the Grizzlies' advantage to 77-53. After Minnesota once again whittled it to 13 behind two baskets from Corey Brewer, Memphis held the Wolves scoreless for nearly five minutes to start the fourth period, taking its largest lead at 93-68 on Conley's layup with 7:24 left. Kevin Love led Minnesota with 16 points while Gorgui Dieng contributed 11 points and 17 rebounds.

The Nov. 10 victory snapped a 22-game series drought for the Wolves, dating to the 117-107 double-OT win on Mar. 6, 2007 at Target Center.

**First Meeting:** Ricky Rubio notched the second triple-double of his career (12 pts/10 reb/14 ast) and the Timberwolves opened with the highest-scoring quarter in club history (47 points) en route to their first victory vs. Los Angeles in over six years, 113-90, on Nov. 10 at Staples Center. Kevin Martin finished with 27 points for Minnesota, while Steve Blake's 19 points topped the Lakers.

**Second Meeting:** Swaggy P tallied 25 points and Pau Gasol scored nine of his 21 points during a game-closing 14-2 run to lift L.A. to a 104-91 victory over the Timberwolves on Dec. 20 at Staples Center. Gasol added 13 rebounds and eight assists for the Lakers. Kevin Love paced Minnesota with 25 points and 13 rebounds, while Nikola Pekovic contributed 22 points and 13 boards.

**Third Meeting:** Kevin Martin scored a season-high 32 points and Kevin Love added 31 points and 17 rebounds as the Timberwolves ended a seven-year home drought vs. the Lakers with a 109-99 victory on Feb. 4 at Target Center. Ricky Rubio collected 13 assists for Minnesota, while Swaggy P led Los Angeles with 24 points and Manny Harris tacked on 19.

**WOLF TRACKS:** Minnesota halted its three-game losing streak with Wednesday's 107-83 triumph over Atlanta, its largest winning margin ever vs. the Hawks... The skid began with the 129-106 defeat at Houston on Mar. 20 and also included losses vs. Phoenix (127-120 on Sunday) and at Memphis (109-92 on Monday); Phoenix spotted the Wolves a 22-point advantage before rallying to win... Minnesota kicked off its two-night Texas swing with a 123-122 OT win at Dallas on Mar. 19... Minnesota held on for a 104-102 home win over Sacramento on Mar. 16; two nights earlier, they suffered a 105-93 loss at Charlotte... The Wolves finished a 2-2 homestand by defeating Milwaukee 112-101 on Mar. 11... The stand began with a 118-106 loss to New York on Mar. 5, snapping the Wolves' three-game winning streak (all on the road), and continued with a 114-101 win over Detroit (Mar. 7) and a 111-104 loss to Toronto (Mar. 9)... Minnesota capped a 4-1 West Coast trip with the 132-128 win at Denver on Mar. 3... It's the sixth time in club history they've won four games on a single trip, the first since December 2005... The Wolves began with a 121-104 win at Utah on Feb. 22 before suffering a 108-97 loss the next night in Portland... Minnesota spotted Phoenix an 81-75 lead entering the fourth quarter on Feb. 25 before rallying to win 110-101, just their third victory this year when trailing after three... Minnesota returned from the All-Star Break with a 104-91 win over Indiana on Feb. 19; they'd snapped their season-high four-game losing streak with the 117-90 rout of Denver on Feb. 12...

**MARGINAL INFORMATION:** Minnesota recorded its franchise-record 11th 20-point victory with Wednesday's decision vs. Atlanta; the Wolves have also built leads of 30+ points in 12 of their 70 games to date (a league high), the top single-season total in the NBA since Utah had 14 such games in 1996-97... The 23-point defeat Mar. 20 at Houston represents the Wolves' largest of the season; they lost by 21 vs. Miami on Dec. 7... Minnesota's 88 points vs. New Orleans on Jan. 29 are the fewest they've scored in a victory this season and mark just the second time they've won in the past 30 when tallying fewer than 90... The Wolves claimed a 121-120 victory at Golden State on Jan. 24 -- their first this season in a game decided by four points or less, snapping a 14-game losing streak in that category; they're now 4-12 when the final margin is four or less, including 3-0 in March... The Wolves have won three times when being held below 100; the 98-72 victory over Utah on Jan. 18 halted an 18-game losing streak in that category (0-10 this year)...

**OFF TARGET:** Houston's 129 points and 57.6% accuracy on Mar. 20 are both season bests vs. the Wolves; prior to Wednesday's win over Atlanta, they'd allowed 100+ points in 11 straight games, surrendering 113.9 ppg (50.8%) in that span... It's Minnesota's longest such one-season streak since a 15-game run in late 2009-10 (Feb. 26-Mar. 28)... Minnesota shot a season-high 55.7% Jan. 1 vs. New Orleans, the first of three 50%+ nights in January (eight total)... The Wolves have won 10 in a row (8-0 this season) and 20 of their last 21 when shooting 50%+; including Atlanta's 37.8% outing on Wednesday, Minnesota has also won its last 20 starts when holding the opponent below 40%... Minnesota finished at 29.3% in the Dec. 7 loss to Miami, the lowest single-game percentage in club history... Overall, the Wolves rank 25th in the NBA at 44.0% but are 4th in scoring (106.3 ppg)... At the other end, Minnesota has allowed 50%+ accuracy 20 times (going 5-15); they're last in the NBA in FG percentage defense (47.2%) and 24th in scoring defense (103.3 ppg)...

**THREES & FREES:** The Wolves' 52-for-64 effort Mar. 3 at Denver shattered the franchise single-game records for FTs made and attempted... Minnesota is 3rd by averaging 27.8 FTAs per night; they also lead the league in FTs made per game (21.7) and rank 7th in FT accuracy (78.0%) and 3rd in fouls drawn (23.5 per game)... At the other end, Minnesota's opponents are attempting just 19.8 FTs per night, the fewest in the NBA this season... The Wolves went 16-for-26 from three-point range Jan. 6 at Philadelphia, a season high for makes; Minnesota is 25-15 when hitting 7+ treys... They've climbed to 37.1% (73-for-197) over the past nine starts, after shooting at just a 28.1% clip (36-for-128) in the previous six... The Wolves rank 17th in three-pointers made (7.5 per game) but 26th in three-point accuracy (34.3%)... At the other end, San Antonio's 9-for-13 (69.2%) effort Jan. 12 is a season high percentage vs. Minnesota; they've allowed 38.3% (133-for-347) from long range in the last 15, after giving up 32.2% in the previous five contests...

**THE BOARD REPORT:** Charlotte posted a 54-35 edge on Mar. 14, the largest margin the Wolves have faced this year; they've come up short in 18 of the past 28 games (including nine of the last 10)... That 28-game stretch began with a 50-40 deficit at Portland on Jan. 25; before that, Minnesota had been outboarded in just seven of its previous 37... The Wolves outrebounded Utah 49-34 on Feb. 22, their seventh double-digit advantage overall; they were on the short end of a 54-42 count Monday at Memphis... Oklahoma City posted a 45-40 edge on Jan. 4, the first time Minnesota had fallen short at home since Nov. 6 vs. Golden State... The Wolves rank 8th in total rebound pct (.513), 12th in offensive rebound pct (.273) and 12th in defensive rebound pct (.752)... They've compiled a +0.7 rpg advantage for the year (44.9-44.2), but are being outboarded by -7.2 rpg (40.3-47.5) in the past 10 contests...

**THIEVERY CORPORATION:** Minnesota tallied 32 points off 26 Atlanta TOs on Wednesday, the fifth time this year they've scored 30+ (season best is 37 at Houston on Nov. 23)... The Hawks' 26 TOs tie the most Minnesota has forced this season (the 18th time they've generated 20+)... The season-high 17-steal effort vs. Atlanta marks the 25th time the Wolves have reached double digits; they had 29 such games a year ago, which was their top total since 2000-01... Ricky Rubio and Corey Brewer have combined for 288 steals, the most-prolific duo in the NBA this year (Thaddeus Young/Michael Carter-Williams are 2nd with 262)... The Wolves committed a season-low five TOs Dec. 27 vs. Washington; they've cut their TOs to 12.3 per game in 13 March starts, including a seven-TO night Mar. 11 vs. Milwaukee... Minnesota ranks 3rd in the NBA in fewest TOs (13.5 per game) and 3rd in TOs forced (16.4)...

**THE NOISE IS WORKING:** Monday's game at Memphis wrapped up the 17th of 21 back-to-back sets for the Wolves in 2013-14; they're 11-6 in the openers and 4-13 on the tail ends of back-to-backs thus far... Minnesota concluded a five-game road trip Mar. 3 in Denver; starting Mar. 5 vs. New York, they're now in a four-week stretch that sees them play 10 of 15 at home... On the other hand, beginning with the Dec. 28 win at Milwaukee, the Wolves have gone 10-10 on the road but 11-10 at Target Center... The Mar. 14 game at Charlotte capped a run of five straight vs. Eastern foes... The Feb. 8 game vs. Portland finished the second of two four-games-in-five-nights grinds for Minnesota (also Nov. 19-23)... Seven of the Wolves' first eight in March were vs. sub-500 opponents; however, starting with the Mar. 19 victory in Dallas, 12 of Minnesota's final 16 contests will be against teams currently sporting winning records...

**WOLF TRACKS:** Minnesota ended 2012-13 with a 31-51 record, its highest victory total since finishing 32-50 in 2006-07; this year's winning percentage (.378) fell short of the .394 (26-40) mark the Wolves compiled a season ago... Minnesota's season was highlighted by two wins apiece vs. San Antonio, Oklahoma City and Denver, the Western Conference's top three teams record-wise... Minnesota has now missed the postseason in nine straight seasons, after advancing to the playoffs every year from 1996-97 through 2003-04 (eight)... The current absence is the longest active postseason drought; Sacramento (seven), Toronto (five) and Washington (five) are next on that list... The Wolves began the season 16-15 (through Jan. 8), then endured a 7-28 stretch (Jan. 9-Mar. 21) before splitting their final 16 contests... The 107-101 home win over Detroit on Apr. 6 marked Rick Adelman's 1000th victory as an NBA head coach... Minnesota closed with four wins in its final seven away from Target Center, including a season-high three-game road winning streak (Mar. 22-26-Apr. 3)... The wins at Detroit (105-82 on Mar. 26) and Phoenix (117-86 on Mar. 22) marked the first time in club history that the Wolves have registered 20-point victories in consecutive road games... The final 31-point spread at Phoenix equals the second-largest road win in franchise history (and ties the 10th-largest overall); they won by 35 at Philadelphia (119-84) on Dec. 8, 2004... Prior to the three-game road winning streak, Minnesota had suffered through an 11-week stretch that saw them drop 17 of 18 road games; the Feb. 11 victory at Cleveland bisected droughts of eight (Jan. 9-Feb. 10) and nine games (Feb. 22-Mar. 21)... Memphis pulled away for a 99-86 win on Mar. 30 at Target Center... Minnesota took a 67-65 lead into the fourth period before being outscored 34-19 by the Grizzlies; they dropped 13 games when leading after three (second behind Cleveland's 14) and lost 18 games after building leads of 10+ points... Houston spotted the Wolves a 20-point, 3rd-quarter cushion before rallying to win 108-100 on Mar. 15; it's the biggest lead Minnesota let slip away this year and the 13th time in franchise history they've lost after building a lead of 20+ points...

**SCHEDULE NOTES:** Minnesota enjoyed a 5-5 final month, after compiling a 1-26 record over its previous three Aprils... The Apr. 17 triumph at San Antonio marked the Wolves' first victory in a season finale in five years (110-101 OT vs. Milwaukee, Apr. 16, 2008), and also halted a 16-game losing streak at the AT&T Center that dated to January 2004... Minnesota faced four groupings of four-games-in-five-nights this season, including three in the final five weeks (Mar. 9-13, Mar. 26-30, Apr. 9-13)... The Mar. 30 game vs. Memphis completed Minnesota's second seven-games-in-10-nights run in March (Mar. 9-18, Mar. 21-30); they went 8-14 on the tail end of back-to-back sets this season, after going 5-15 in those situations a year ago... The Wolves finished 20-21 for their best home record since going 20-21 in 2006-07... Minnesota drew an SRO 20,340 vs. Houston on Dec. 26, the third-largest crowd in Target Center history...

Took the Kings to the NBA Playoffs in each of his eight seasons there, including a trip to the Western Conference Finals in 2002; he compiled a 395-229 record (.633) to become the winningest coach in franchise history...
