Last Game: Saturday, Apr. 5 – Orlando 100, Minnesota 92

Arron Afflalo scored 18 points and Victor Oladipo scored 10 of his 16 points in the fourth quarter to help Orlando rally from a 13-point deficit to beat the Timberwolves, 100-92, on Saturday night at the Amway Center. Minnesota led 26-25 after one quarter, but the Magic opened the second period with a 13-3 surge to take their largest lead of the night at 38-29 on Tobias Harris' jumper at the 6:37 mark. The Wolves countered by scoring the game's next 13 points and went into halftime clinging to a 48-46 lead. Minnesota then hit 10 of its first 13 shots in the third quarter, building a 74-61 advantage on Corey Brewer's layup at the 3:56 mark. Orlando whittled the deficit to five heading into the fourth and went ahead 88-83 when Kyle O'Quinn's dunk capped a 14-4 burst. Baskets by Brewer, Luc Richard Mbah a Mouté and Ricky Rubio reclaimed a one-point lead for the Wolves with 4:26 remaining, but Oladipo responded with a 3-pointer and O'Quinn's three-point play doubled Orlando's lead to 96-90. O'Quinn totaled 14 points and 13 rebounds for the Magic, while Rubio led Minnesota with 18 points and 10 assists and Brewer chipped in 15 points.

Previous Game: Friday, Apr. 4 – Minnesota 122, Miami 121 (2OT)

Kevin Love scored 28 points and Chase Budinger added a season-high 24 as the Timberwolves edged Miami, 122-121 in two OTs, on Friday night at AmericanAirlines Arena. The Heat built a 10-point lead late in the opening quarter before Minnesota responded with a 16-4 burst that featured a pair of Budinger 3-pointers. Chris Bosh pushed Miami's lead to 52-42 with 2:25 left in the half, but Gorgui Dieng's dunk capped a 10-0 finish that tied it and treys from Ricky Rubio and J.J. Barea gave the Wolves a 60-54 edge early in the third. Dieng extended that to 72-63 at the 3:20 mark before LeBron James tallied 12 points to rally Miami to within two entering the fourth quarter. Triples from Barea and Budinger helped keep Minnesota in front, but the Heat forced overtime with a Mario Chalmers free throw with :03.9 left. The lead changed hands 10 times in the first extra session, but the Wolves went ahead on Love's trey at the :29.7 mark of the second overtime. After Bosh tied it with a long-range strike of his own, Corey Brewer's free throw with :01.8 to play provided the winning margin. James finished with 34 points and four steals for the Heat.

First Meeting: Tony Parker scored 29 points and Manu Ginóbili added 16 of his 20 points in the fourth quarter as San Antonio rallied for a 117-110 victory over the Timberwolves on Dec. 13 at the AT&T Center. Kevin Love poured in 42 points -- including a franchise-record-tying eight 3-pointers -- and grabbed 14 rebounds for Minnesota, while Nikola Pekovic added 18 points and 11 boards.

Second Meeting: Kawhi Leonard scored 13 of his 17 points in the second half and Tony Parker added 14 points and 10 assists as San Antonio pulled away to a 104-86 victory over the Wolves on Jan. 12 at the AT&T Center. Tim Duncan netted 15 points, eight rebounds and five assists for the Spurs, while Nikola Pekovic led Minnesota with 22 points and Kevin Love chipped in 14.

HIT THE GROUND RUNNING: Minnesota outscored the Lakers 47-23 in the opening 12 minutes on Nov. 10, marking the highest-scoring quarter in franchise history. *The Wolves lead the NBA in 1st-quarter scoring, tallying 28.6 points (46.8%) through 76 starts, and rank 3rd in 1st-quarter scoring margin at +2.7 points (28.6-25.9).* A quarter-by-quarter look at 2013-14 to date for Minnesota:

DIENG EARNS ROOKIE HONOR: On Apr. 1, Timberwolves center Gorgui Dieng was named the NBA's Western Conference Rookie of the Month for games played in March. Dieng, the 21st overall pick in the 2013 NBA Draft, ranked 2nd among all rookies in rebounding (8.3 rpg) and 5th in the West in scoring (8.6 ppg) while shooting 61.3% from the floor in 14 March contests. He began a string of six consecutive starts with a 12-point, 11-rebound, five-block effort in the Mar. 16 win over Sacramento, becoming the first player since Dwight Howard in 2004 to notch a double-double with 4+ blocks in his first NBA start. He collected five point/rebound double-doubles in total, highlighted by registering season highs of 22 points, 21 rebounds and four assists Mar. 20 at Houston, and was Minnesota's top rebounder on six occasions. Dieng is the fifth rookie in franchise history to earn the monthly award, joining Stephon Marbury (January 1997), Randy Foye (December 2006), Kevin Love (March 2009) and Ricky Rubio (January 2012).

BREWER'S BLEND: Corey Brewer currently ranks 6th in the NBA in fast break scoring by tallying 4.9 ppg in that category. Meanwhile, Nikola Pekovic (5.2 ppg) and Kevin Love (4.5 ppg) rank 2-3 in second-chance scoring, and Pekovic stands 5th on league leader board for points in the paint (13.2 ppg). WOLF TRACKS: Minnesota capped its weekend Florida swing with Saturday's 100-92 setback at Orlando, slipping to 38-38 on the season... One night earlier, the Wolves snapped a three-game road skid by holding off Miami, 122-121 in double-OT; it's the 16th time they've played multiple overtimes (first since Mar. 23, 2012 at Oklahoma City)... Despite the victory, Minnesota was officially eliminated from playoff contention on Friday following wins by Dallas, Memphis and Phoenix... Minnesota began the month with a 102-88 victory over Memphis on Apr. 2... The L.A. Clippers downed the Wolves, 114-104, on Mar. 3, one night after Minnesota suffered a 114-99 loss at Brooklyn... The Wolves completed a 2-0 homestand with the 143-107 triumph over the Lakers on Mar. 28; they'd halted a three-game drought with the 107-83 win vs. Atlanta on Mar. 26... The skid began with the 129-106 defeat at Houston on Mar. 20 and also included losses vs. Phoenix (127-120 on Mar. 23) and at Memphis (109-92 on Mar. 24); Phoenix spotted the Wolves a 22-point edge before rallying to win... Minnesota began its Texas swing with a 123-122 OT win at Dallas on Mar. 19... The Wolves finished a 2-2 homestand by beating Milwaukee 112-101 on Mar. 11... The stand began with a 118-106 loss to New York on Mar. 5 and continued with a 114-101 triumph over Detroit and a 111-104 loss to Toronto... Minnesota capped a 4-1 West Coast trip with the 132-128 win at Denver on Mar. 3; it's the sixth time in club history they've won four games on a single trip, the first since December 2005... Minnesota spotted Phoenix an 81-75 lead entering the fourth on Feb. 25 before rallying to win 110-101, their third victory this year when trailing after three... Minnesota returned from the All-Star Break with a 104-91 win over Indiana on Feb. 19...

MARGINAL INFORMATION: Minnesota recorded its franchise-record 12th 20-point victory with the Mar. 28 decision vs. Los Angeles; the Wolves have also now built leads of 30+ points in 13 of their 76 games, the top single-season total in the NBA since Utah had 14 such games in 1996-97... The 23-point defeat Mar. 20 at Houston represents the Wolves' largest of the season; they lost by 21 vs. Miami on Dec. 7... Minnesota's 88 points vs. New Orleans on Jan. 29 are the fewest they've scored in a victory this season and mark just the second time they've won in the past 30 when tallying fewer than 90... The Wolves claimed a 121-120 victory at Golden State on Jan. 24 -- their first this season in a game decided by four points or less, snapping a 14-game losing streak in that category; they're now 5-12 when the final margin is four or less, including 4-0 since Mar. 1... The Wolves have won three times this year when being held below 100 points; the 98-72 victory over Utah on Jan. 18 halted an 18-game losing streak in that category (0-10 this year)...

ON TARGET: Minnesota shot 53.1% Apr. 2 vs. Memphis, its 10th 50%+ night of the year... The Wolves set club single-game records for points scored (143) and FG accuracy (67.1%) in the Mar. 28 victory over the Lakers... On the other hand, Houston's 129 points and 57.6% accuracy on Mar. 20 are both season bests vs. the Wolves; prior to the Mar. 26 victory over Atlanta, they'd allowed 100+ in 11 straight games, surrendering 113.9 ppg (50.8%) in that span... The Wolves have won 12 in a row (10-0 this season) and 22 of 23 when shooting 50%+; including Atlanta's 37.8% effort on Mar. 26, Minnesota has also won its last 21 starts when holding the opponent below 40%... Minnesota finished at 29.3% in the Dec. 7 loss to Miami, the lowest single-game percentage in club history... Overall, the Wolves rank 21st in the NBA at 44.5% but are 3rd in scoring (106.7 ppg)... At the other end, Minnesota has allowed 50%+ accuracy 22 times (going 5-17); they're 29th in the NBA in FG percentage defense (47.1%) and 26th in scoring defense (103.6 ppg)...

THREES & FREES: The Wolves' 52-for-64 effort Mar. 3 at Denver shattered the franchise single-game records for FTs made and attempted... Minnesota is 3rd by averaging 27.7 FTAs per night; they also rank 2nd in the NBA in FTs made per game (21.5), 9th in FT accuracy (77.7%) and 3rd in fouls drawn (23.4 per game)... At the other end, Minnesota's opponents are attempting just 19.7 FTs per night, the fewest in the NBA this season... The Wolves went 16-for-26 from three-point range Jan. 6 at Philadelphia, a season high for makes; they've reached double digits 18 times, going 13-5 in those... Meanwhile, Saturday's 1-for-15 effort at Orlando is a season low; they're at 30.7% (31-for-101) over the last five... The Wolves rank 17th in three-pointers made (7.4 per game) but 26th in three-point accuracy (34.2%)... At the other end, San Antonio's 9-for-13 (69.2%) effort Jan. 12 is a season high percentage vs. Minnesota...

THE BOARD REPORT: Minnesota outrebounded the Lakers 49-26 on Mar. 28, their largest margin of the season and seventh double-digit advantage overall; they enjoyed a 54-33 cushion vs. Charlotte on Jan. 10... On the flipside, the Bobcats posted a 54-35 edge on Mar. 14, the largest margin the Wolves have faced this year; they've come up short in 22 of the past 34 contests... That stretch began with a 50-40 deficit at Portland on Jan. 25; before that, Minnesota had been outboarded in just seven of its previous 37... Oklahoma City posted a 45-40 edge on Jan. 4, the first time Minnesota had fallen short at home since Nov. 6 vs. Golden State... The Wolves rank 8th in total rebound pct (.511), 8th in offensive rebound pct (.273) and 13th in defensive rebound pct (.748)... They've compiled a +0.8 rpg advantage for the year (44.7-44.0), but are being outboarded by -4.1 rpg (41.1-45.2) in the past 16 contests...

THIEVERY CORPORATION: Minnesota tallied 30 points off 23 Orlando TOs on Saturday, the sixth time they've scored 30+ (season best is 37 at Houston on Nov. 23)... Atlanta's 26 TOs on Mar. 26 tie the most Minnesota has forced in 2013-14 (one of 20 times they've generated 20+)... The season-high 17-steal effort vs. Atlanta is one of 28 times the Wolves have reached double digits; they had 29 such games a year ago, which was their top total since 2000-01... Ricky Rubio and Corey Brewer have combined for 314 steals, the most-prolific duo in the NBA this year (Thaddeus Young/Michael Carter-Williams are 2nd with 283)... The Wolves committed a season-low five TOs Dec. 27 vs. Washington; however, they're averaging 17.6 TOs in the last seven games, after coughing it up just 11.3 times per contest in the previous 10... Minnesota ranks 6th in the NBA in fewest TOs (13.8 per game) and 3rd in TOs forced (16.4)...

THE NOISE IS WORKING: Tonight's game kicks off the 20th of 21 back-to-back sets for the Wolves in 2013-14; they're 12-7 in the openers and 4-15 on the tail ends of back-to-backs thus far... Minnesota concluded a five-game road trip Mar. 3 in Denver; meanwhile, the Apr. 2 victory over Memphis capped a four-week stretch that saw them play 10 of 15 at home... The Mar. 14 game at Charlotte completed a run of five straight vs. Eastern foes... The Feb. 8 game vs. Portland finished the second of two four-games-in-five-nights grinds for Minnesota (also Nov. 19-23)... Seven of the Wolves' first eight in March were vs. sub-.500 opponents; however, starting with the Mar. 19 victory in Dallas, 12 of Minnesota's final 16 contests are against teams currently sporting winning records...

WOLF TRACKS: Minnesota ended 2012-13 with a 31-51 record, its highest victory total since finishing 32-50 in 2006-07; this year's winning percentage (.378) fell short of the .394 (26-40) mark the Wolves compiled a season ago... Minnesota's season was highlighted by two wins apiece vs. San Antonio, Oklahoma City and Denver, the Western Conference's top three teams record-wise... Minnesota has now missed the postseason in nine straight seasons, after advancing to the playoffs every year from 1996-97 through 2003-04 (eight)... The current absence is the longest active postseason drought; Sacramento (seven), Toronto (five) and Washington (five) are next on that list... The Wolves began the season 16-15 (through Jan. 8), then endured a 7-28 stretch (Jan. 9-Mar. 21) before splitting their final 16 contests... The 107-101 home win over Detroit on Apr. 6 marked Rick Adelman's 1000th victory as an NBA head coach... Minnesota closed with four wins in its final seven away from Target Center, including a season-high three-game road winning streak (Mar. 22-26-Apr. 3)... The wins at Detroit (105-82 on Mar. 26) and Phoenix (117-86 on Mar. 22) marked the first time in club history that the Wolves have registered 20-point victories in consecutive road games... The final 31-point spread at Phoenix equals the second-largest road win in franchise history (and ties the 10th-largest overall); they won by 35 at Philadelphia (119-84) on Dec. 8, 2004... Prior to the three-game road winning streak, Minnesota had suffered through an 11-week stretch that saw them drop 17 of 18 road games; the Feb. 11 victory at Cleveland bisected droughts of eight (Jan. 9-Feb. 10) and nine games (Feb. 22-Mar. 21)... Memphis pulled away for a 99-86 win on Mar. 30 at Target Center... Minnesota took a 67-65 lead into the fourth period before being outscored 34-19 by the Grizzlies; they dropped 13 games when leading after three (second behind Cleveland's 14) and lost 18 games after building leads of 10+ points... Houston spotted the Wolves a 20-point, 3rd-quarter cushion before rallying to win 108-100 on Mar. 15; it's the biggest lead Minnesota let slip away this year and the 13th time in franchise history they've lost after building a lead of 20+ points...

SCHEDULE NOTES: Minnesota enjoyed a 5-5 final month, after compiling a 1-26 record over its previous three Aprils... The Apr. 17 triumph at San Antonio marked the Wolves' first victory in a season finale in five years (110-101 OT vs. Milwaukee, Apr. 16, 2008), and also halted a 16-game losing streak at the AT&T Center that dated to January 2004... Minnesota faced four groupings of four-games-in-five-nights this season, including three in the final five weeks (Mar. 9-13, Mar. 26-30, Apr. 9-13)... The Mar. 30 game vs. Memphis completed Minnesota's second seven-games-in-10-nights run in March (Mar. 9-18, Mar. 21-30); they went 8-14 on the tail end of back-to-back sets this season, after going 5-15 in those situations a year ago... The Wolves finished 20-21 for their best home record since going 20-21 in 2006-07... Minnesota drew an SRO 20,340 vs. Houston on Dec. 26, the third-largest crowd in Target Center history...

Spent two seasons (1995-96 and 1996-97) with the Golden State Warriors before moving on to Sacramento in 1998... Took the Kings to the NBA Playoffs in each of his eight seasons there, including a trip to the Western Conference Finals in 2002; he compiled a 395-229 record (.633) to become the winningest coach in franchise history...
