DeMarcus Cousins rang up 31 points and 18 rebounds, and Ben McLemore scored 13 of his season-high 22 points in the third quarter as Sacramento rallied past the Timberwolves, 113-101, on Saturday night at Target Center. Minnesota led 24-21 after one period and grabbed its largest advantage when Mo Williams made it 39-32 midway through the second. A pair of late baskets from Gorgui Dieng kept the Wolves in front by four at halftime, but McLemore tallied 11 points during a 17-6 third-quarter burst that put the Kings ahead to stay. Cousins pushed the lead to 78-67 at the 2:13 mark before a last-second 3-pointer by Zach LaVine pulled Minnesota to within seven entering the fourth. Shabazz Muhammad cut it to 88-84 at the 9:34 mark, but Derrick Williams struck from long range to stall the comeback. Andrew Wiggins brought the Wolves to within 101-96 with 3:11 left before Darren Collison's tray was followed by a dunk from Cousins to put the game out of reach. Collison totaled 19 points for the Kings, while Wiggins led Minnesota with a season-high 29 points and four steals, and Williams contributed 11 points and 12 assists.

Previous Game: Friday, Nov. 21 – San Antonio 121, Minnesota 92

Tony Parker scored 23 of his season-high 28 points in the first half as San Antonio shot 13-for-21 from 3-point distance in rolling to a 121-92 victory over the Timberwolves on Friday night at Target Center. Parker had 13 points in the first quarter and Manu Ginobili's late trey gave the Spurs a 29-26 lead. Minnesota went ahead briefly when Robbie Hummel made it 30-29 early in the second, but back-to-back 3-pointers from Danny Green kicked off a run of 13 unanswered points that put San Antonio on top 54-37 with four minutes left in the half. The Wolves countered with an 11-2 burst to narrow the gap to 11 by intermission, but opened the second half misfiring on seven of their first eight shots while the Spurs scored on their first five possessions as the lead ballooned to 72-50. Minnesota could get no closer than 17 after that despite nine third-quarter points from Andrew Wiggins. San Antonio extended the margin to 29 entering the fourth and took its largest lead of the night when Austin Daye's 3-pointer made it 117-83 with 2:04 to play. Green finished with 18 points for the Spurs while Anthony Bennett led Minnesota with a career-high 20 points.

Second Meeting: Kevin Love scored 27 points and Kevin Martin added 26 as the Timberwolves spotted Milwaukee an early 11-point lead before rallying to win, 112-101, on Mar. 11 at Target Center. J.J. Barea finished with 19 points and Ricky Rubio dealt 10 assists for Minnesota. Brandon Knight led the Bucks with 21 points while Zaza Pachulia handed out a career-high 10 assists.

The Nov. 10 victory snapped a 22-game series drought for the Wolves, dating to the 117-107 double-OT win on Mar. 6, 2007 at Target Center.

First Meeting: Ricky Rubio notched the second triple-double of his career (12 pts/10 reb/14 ast) and the Timberwolves opened with the highest-scoring quarter in club history (47 points) en route to their first victory vs. Los Angeles in over six years, 113-90, on Nov. 10 at Staples Center. Kevin Martin finished with 27 points for Minnesota, while Steve Blake's 19 points topped the Lakers.

Second Meeting: Nick Young tallied 25 points and Pau Gasol scored nine of his 21 points during a game-closing 14-2 run to lift L.A. to a 104-91 victory over the Timberwolves on Dec. 20 at Staples Center. Gasol added 13 rebounds and eight assists for the Lakers. Kevin Love paced Minnesota with 25 points and 13 rebounds, while Nikola Pekovic contributed 22 points and 13 boards.

Third Meeting: Kevin Martin scored a season-high 32 points and Kevin Love added 31 points and 17 rebounds as the Timberwolves ended a seven-year home drought vs. the Lakers with a 109-99 victory on Feb. 4 at Target Center. Ricky Rubio collected 13 assists for Minnesota, while Nick Young led Los Angeles with 24 points and Manny Harris tacked on 19.

Fourth Meeting: Nikola Pekovic returned to score 26 points and Kevin Love netted his second triple-double of the season (22 points, 10 rebounds, 10 assists) as the Timberwolves posted a 143-107 win over Los Angeles on Mar. 28 at Target Center. Kevin Martin tacked on 17 points for Minnesota. Kent Bazemore's 21 points led the Lakers with Jodie Meeks chipping in 19.

ROSTER NOTES: On Oct. 27, the Timberwolves announced their 15-man Opening Night roster, having reached the limit by waiving guard J.J. Barea... Previously, Minnesota had waived guard Brady Heslip (Oct. 25) and center Kyrlo Fesenko (Oct. 20), after starting training camp with an 18-player roster... Of the 15 players who finished 2013-14 on the Timberwolves roster, nine are back this year... Six new faces dot Minnesota's roster, including free-agent signee Mo Williams... Anthony Bennett, Andrew Wiggins and Thaddeus Young were acquired in a three-team trade involving Cleveland and Philadelphia on Aug. 23... Three rookies are on the roster; Wiggins was chosen 1st overall by the Cavaliers in the 2014 NBA Draft, while Minnesota used its own selections to tab Zach LaVine (1st round, 13th overall) and Glenn Robinson III (2nd round, 40th overall)... Last October, the Wolves returned nine of 15 players from their 2012-13 roster; they kept only seven of 15 players from 2011-12 to 2012-13... The current roster averages 4.0 years of NBA experience and has an average age of 25.6 years; last year's Opening Night group was at 3.7 and 26.0, respectively (3.6 and 26.5 in 2012-13)... Nikola Pekovic takes over atop the seniority list, beginning his fifth season in Minnesota; Ricky Rubio enters year number four...

WOLF TRACKS: Minnesota slipped to 1-2 on its current four-game homestand with Saturday's 113-101 loss to Sacramento... One night earlier, San Antonio downed the Wolves, 121-92, equaling Minnesota's 6th-biggest home loss of all-time... The Spurs finished 13-for-21 (61.9%) from beyond the arc, the third time in their last six games the Wolves have permitted 10+ three-pointers; opponents are shooting a combined 48.2% (66-for-137) from three-point distance in the last six... Minnesota snapped its five-game losing streak with the 115-99 triumph over New York on Nov. 19, its first win vs. the Knicks at Target Center since Jan. 31, 2010... Dallas handed the Wolves a 131-117 loss on Nov. 15, one night after New Orleans walloped Minnesota, 139-91... The final 48-point spread in the latter game represents the Wolves' largest losing margin of all-time; they'd suffered a 42-point loss (128-86) at Orlando on Nov. 3, 2010... It also ties the 6th-largest spread in the NBA in the past decade, coming one night after Dallas' 53-point win (123-70) over Philadelphia... Houston dealt Minnesota a 113-101 loss on Nov. 12 in Mexico City; each of the Wolves' last seven contests has been decided by 10+ points, after five straight single-digit finishes... Minnesota completed an 0-2 swing through Florida after suffering a 102-92 defeat on Nov. 8 in Miami, enabling the Heat to avenge a 122-121 double-OT loss last Apr. 4 at AmericanAirlines Arena... Orlando dealt Minnesota a 112-103 OT setback on Nov. 7, the Wolves' seventh consecutive road loss in the series dating to a 102-101 triumph on Apr. 11, 2008... Orlando rang up 18 points in the extra session, tying the 2nd-highest total allowed by Minnesota in an OT period (19 at Utah, Nov. 24, 1997; 18 at Dallas, Feb. 8, 1994)... The Wolves began the extended trip with a 97-91 victory over Brooklyn on Nov. 5, their lone road triumph to date... Chicago's last-second 106-105 victory on Nov. 1 at Target Center was the Wolves' third straight game decided by six points or fewer... A year ago, Minnesota went 8-15 in that category, winning six of its final nine after a 2-12 open...

FINDING THE RANGE: Minnesota shot a season-high 50.0% on Nov. 15 at Dallas, halting a run of six straight games in which they'd finished below 45%... The Wolves followed up by shooting 49.4% in the Nov. 19 win over New York; they're 2-2 when hitting 45%+ (1-7 when falling short)... Prior to the Dallas game, Minnesota's season best was a 48.7% outing in the home opening victory vs. Detroit on Oct. 30... Meanwhile, New Orleans shot a torrid 66.7% on Nov. 14, tying the highest FG percentage ever vs. Minnesota (Detroit also hit 66.7% on Nov. 8, 1994)... The Wolves have surrendered 50%+ accuracy five times in their last eight starts, including the Spurs' 54.8% effort on Nov. 21; they're permitting a combined 53.4% (and 116.3 ppg) in those eight contests... Minnesota's best defensive effort to date came on Oct. 30, when Detroit was limited to 41.8%; Minnesota is 2-0 when keeping its foe below 45% but 1-9 when allowing 45%+... On the year, the Wolves rank 21st in FG accuracy (44.1%) but last in defensive FG percentage (51.1%)...

DOUBLE VISION: San Antonio outboarded Minnesota 53-34 on Nov. 21, the Wolves' largest deficit of the season... Over the last eight years (since Nov. 7, 2006), the Wolves are 7-88 when facing a double-digit board deficit (50-290 all-time)... Three different Wolves players notched double-doubles in the Nov. 5 victory at Brooklyn: Nikola Pekovic (16 pts/11 reb), Thaddeus Young (12 pts/12 reb) and Ricky Rubio (14 pts/12 ast)... Minnesota enjoyed six such games last season, most recently in the Apr. 11 win over Houston... Overall, the Wolves piled up a 51-42 rebounding advantage vs. the Nets on Nov. 5, they've held the edge in eight of 12 starts to date (most recently 35-33 vs. New York on Nov. 19)... Minnesota put together a 25-4 edge in 2nd-chance points at Miami on Nov. 8 (helped by a 17-6 margin on the offensive boards), they've held the upper hand in that category eight times in 12 games... On the year, Minnesota ranks 3rd in the NBA in 2nd-chance points scored (15.9 per game) and 3rd in offensive rebounding percentage (.287)...

WOLVES COMPLETE NORTH AMERICAN TOUR: Saturday's game vs. Sacramento concluded the fourth of 19 sets of back-to-back games for the Wolves in 2014-15; the next one begins Sunday in Portland... Minnesota played 21 back-to-back sets a year ago, going 4-17 on the tail ends of those pairs... Last Friday's loss to San Antonio dropped Minnesota to 0-5 vs. the Southwest Division this year; they split their 18 games with Southwest teams in 2013-14... The Nov. 19 victory over New York was the Wolves' first game at Target Center since Nov. 1 vs. Chicago... At 18 days, it's the longest in-season gap between true home games in club history; the six-game international sojourn featured more than 5600 air miles... Minnesota had a 17-day absence from Mar. 21-Apr. 7, 1998 while taking a seven-game trip... The Wolves are now in the midst of a four-week stretch (through Dec. 14) that sees them play 10 of 14 at Target Center, including a pair of four-game homestands... The Nov. 8 game at Miami concluded a run of five in a row vs. Eastern foes...

FOR OPENERS: With the Oct. 30 victory over Detroit, the Wolves have now won 17 of their last 20 home openers, a stretch that began with the 93-92 triumph over the L.A. Lakers on Nov. 7, 1995; they're 18-8 all-time in that category... Flip Saunders remains unbeaten in 10 home openers on the Minnesota bench (the first nine from 1996 through 2004)... The Wolves began 2014-15 with a 105-101 loss in Memphis on Oct. 29, ending a run of 13 consecutive seasons in which they'd opened at Target Center (a string that began in 2001-02)... That's the second-longest home streak in NBA history, and the longest for any team in the same city and arena... The Hawks franchise began 16 consecutive NBA seasons at home (1949-50 through 1964-65) while moving from Tri-Cities to Milwaukee to St. Louis to Atlanta... The active leaders are now the L.A. Lakers, who opened at home for the ninth straight season on Oct. 28...

WOLF TRACKS: Minnesota wrapped up its 2014 preseason schedule with a 5-2 record following last Friday's 113-112 comeback win over Chicago in St. Louis... *It's the Wolves' fifth consecutive winning preseason* (6-2 in 2010, 2-0 in 2011, 5-2 in 2012, 4-3 in 2013); they're now 101-86 all-time in exhibition outings, winning 24 of their last 33 starts... The Chicago triumph wrapped up a five-games-in-eight-nights tour of the Midwest which began in Cedar Rapids (Oct. 17 vs. Milwaukee) and also included stops in Tulsa (Oct. 19 vs. Oklahoma City), the Twin Cities (Oct. 21 vs. Indiana) and Milwaukee (Oct. 22)... The 110-91 win at Milwaukee on Oct. 22 concluded the lone set of back-to-back games for the Wolves this preseason; they beat Indiana, 107-89, on Oct. 21 at Target Center... Minnesota rang up a 112-94 victory over Oklahoma City on Oct. 19; *the Wolves committed just eight TOs while forcing 23 Thunder miscues*... It's the lowest single-game turnover count for Minnesota in any preseason game since coughing it up only seven times at Detroit on Oct. 16, 2005... Meanwhile, the Wolves swiped 17 steals vs. Oklahoma City, with seven different players picking off at least two...

STREAKERS: Minnesota ended the preseason by winning its final four outings, its longest such streak since closing October 2001 with five in a row... The first three of those victories (112-94 over Oklahoma City, 107-89 vs. Indiana, 110-91 at Milwaukee) were all by at least 18 points... It's just the second time in franchise history (pre-, regular or postseason) that the Wolves have accomplished that feat; they enjoyed a three-game run in 2000 (Feb. 22-24-25) with victories over Golden State (112-89), the Clippers (116-91) and at Toronto (107-85)... *Minnesota outscored its opponents by an average of 14.0 ppg (110.5-96.5) during the winning streak*, shooting 47.7% from the floor while limiting its foes to a combined 41.5% accuracy... The Wolves held each of their last four opponents below 45% from the floor (and three of the four under 100 points), after allowing each of their first three foes to crack the Century Mark and top 45% from the floor – including a 53.7% effort by Philadelphia on Oct. 10... The permitted 106.0 ppg and 49.2% accuracy in those three...

WOLF TRACKS: Minnesota ended 2013-14 with a 40-42 record, its best since finishing 44-38 in 2004-05; it's the fourth straight season the Wolves have improved on their previous year's victory total, having posted a 31-51 mark a year ago... Minnesota's season was highlighted by overtime victories at Dallas (123-122 on Mar. 19) and Miami (122-121 in double-OT on Apr. 4), as well as a late win at Golden State (121-120 on Jan. 24)... The Wolves finished 16-25 away from Target Center, their highest road victory total since going 20-21 in 2004-05... Minnesota has now missed the postseason in 10 straight seasons, after advancing to the playoffs every year from 1996-97 through 2003-04 (eight)... The current absence is the longest active postseason drought; Sacramento (eight) and Detroit (five) are next on that list... Minnesota's entire 2013-14 campaign was spent within four games of the .500 mark; they opened the season with three straight wins and were at 7-4 later in November, while the low-water mark came at 24-28 on Feb. 10... The Wolves put together three-game winning streaks on four occasions (Oct. 30-Nov. 3, Jan. 18-24, Feb. 12-22, Feb. 25-Mar. 3) with one four-game skid (Feb. 5-10)... Minnesota finished April with a 4-5 mark, but the four victories were against teams (Memphis, Miami, San Antonio, Houston) with a combined record of 220-108 (.671)... The Apr. 4 victory at Miami was the 800th in club history, while the Apr. 13 game at Sacramento marked the Wolves' 2000th regular-season contest... Minnesota capped a 4-1 West Coast swing with the 132-128 win at Denver on Mar. 3; it's the sixth time in franchise history they've won four games on a single trip, the first since December 2005...

MARGINAL INFORMATION: Minnesota recorded its franchise-record 12th 20-point victory with the Mar. 28 decision vs. Los Angeles; the Wolves also built leads of 30+ points in 13 of their 82 games, the top single-season total in the NBA since Utah had 14 such games in 1996-97... The 23-point defeat Mar. 20 at Houston represented the Wolves' largest of the season; they lost by 21 vs. Miami on Dec. 7... Minnesota's 88 points vs. New Orleans on Jan. 29 were the fewest they scored in a victory last year and marked just the second time they've won in the past 30 when tallying fewer than 90... The Wolves claimed a 121-120 victory at Golden State on Jan. 24 -- their first of the season in a game decided by four points or less, snapping a 14-game losing streak in that category; they finished 6-13 when the final margin was four or less, including 5-1 since Mar. 1... The Wolves won just three times a year ago when being held below 100 points (3-20 overall); the 98-72 victory over Utah on Jan. 18 halted an 18-game losing streak that dated to March 2013...

ON TARGET: Minnesota demolished its previous single-season record for scoring (101.1 ppg in 1997-98) by averaging 106.9 ppg last year to rank 3rd in the NBA... The Wolves set club single-game records for points scored (143) and FG accuracy (67.1%) in the Mar. 28 victory over the L.A. Lakers... On the other hand, Minnesota surrendered 136 points in the Apr. 16 finale vs. Utah, two nights after Golden State had tallied 130... They finished 26th in the NBA in scoring defense (allowing 104.3 ppg) and 29th in defensive FG pct (47.1%)... The Wolves topped 50% on 11 occasions, with the Apr. 14 loss to Golden State just their second in that category in the past two seasons (22-2)... Meanwhile, including Atlanta's 37.8% effort on Mar. 26, Minnesota has won its last 21 starts when holding the opponent below 40%... The Wolves limited Utah to 28.8% accuracy on Jan. 18, their best defensive percentage ever; on the flipside, Minnesota finished at 29.3% in the Dec. 7 loss to Miami, the lowest single-game percentage in club history...

THREES & FREES: The Wolves' 52-for-64 effort Mar. 3 at Denver shattered the franchise single-game records for FTs made and attempted... Minnesota ended 3rd by averaging 28.1 FTAs per night; they were also 2nd in the NBA in FTs made per game (21.8), 9th in FT accuracy (77.8%) and 2nd in fouls drawn (23.6 per game)... At the other end, Minnesota's opponents attempted just 20.1 FTs per night, the fewest in the NBA last season... The Wolves went 16-for-26 from three-point range Jan. 6 at Philadelphia, a season high for makes; they reached double digits 18 times, going 13-5 in those... Meanwhile, the 1-for-14 effort Apr. 5 at Orlando was a season low; they closed at 32.0% (66-for-206) over the last 11 games... The Wolves ranked 17th in three-pointers made (7.3 per game) but 26th in three-point accuracy (34.1%)... For the season, Minnesota set club records for three-pointers made (600) and attempted (1757)...

THE BOARD REPORT: Minnesota outrebounded the Lakers 49-26 on Mar. 28, their largest margin of the season and one of eight double-digit advantages overall; they enjoyed a 52-37 cushion vs. San Antonio on Apr. 8... On the flipside, Charlotte posted a 54-35 edge on Mar. 14, the largest margin the Wolves faced last year; they came up short in 26 of their final 40 contests... That stretch began with a 50-40 deficit at Portland on Jan. 25; before that, Minnesota had been outboarded in just 11 of its first 42 outings... Oklahoma City posted a 45-40 edge on Jan. 4, the first time Minnesota had fallen short at home since Nov. 6 vs. Golden State... The Wolves ranked 10th in total rebound pct (.509), 7th in offensive rebound pct (.274) and 16th in defensive rebound pct (.744)... They compiled a +0.5 rpg advantage for the year (44.7-44.2), but were outboarded by -3.6 rpg (42.2-45.8) over the last 22 contests...

THIEVERY CORPORATION: Minnesota tallied 30 points off 23 Orlando TOs on Apr. 5, the sixth time they scored 30+ (season best was 37 at Houston on Nov. 23)... Atlanta's 26 TOs on Mar. 26 equaled the most Minnesota has forced in 2013-14 (one of 21 times they generated 20+)... The season-high 17-steal effort vs. Atlanta was one of 30 times the Wolves reached double digits, their top total since also posting 30 such games in 2000-01... Ricky Rubio (190) and Corey Brewer (150) combined for 340 steals, the most-prolific duo in the NBA a year ago (Thaddeus Young/Michael Carter-Williams finished 2nd with 297)... The Wolves committed a season-low five TOs Dec. 27 vs. Washington; however, they averaged 16.5 TOs in their final 13 games, after coughing it up just 11.3 times per contest in the previous 10... Minnesota ranked 8th in the NBA in fewest TOs (13.9 per game), 3rd in steals (8.76 spg) and 3rd in TOs forced (16.4)...

SCHEDULE NOTES: Minnesota dropped 10 of its final 16 starts (beginning with the Mar. 20 loss at Houston), after enjoying a six-week stretch at 10-4 that was highlighted by victories over Indiana (Feb. 19) and Dallas (Mar. 19)... The Wolves finished 4-17 on the tail ends of back-to-back sets last year, ending with an 11-game losing streak in that category... Minnesota went 17-13 vs. Eastern opponents, its first winning record against either conference since going 30-22 vs. the West in 2004-05... The Feb. 8 game vs. Portland finished the second of two four-games-in-five-nights grinds for Minnesota (also Nov. 19-23)... Starting with the Mar. 19 overtime win in Dallas, 12 of Minnesota's final 16 contests were against teams sporting winning records... Minnesota drew an SRO 19,888 on Dec. 7 vs. Miami, its lone sellout of 2013-14; the next-largest announced crowd was 18,065 vs. Oklahoma City on Jan. 4...
