Goran Dragic tallied 21 points and eight assists, and Gerald Green added 12 of his 19 points in the fourth quarter as Phoenix beat the Timberwolves for the second time in 10 days with a 110-99 victory on Friday night at US Airways Center. Dragic had 13 points in the opening quarter to help stake the Suns to a 32-27 lead, but Gorgui Dieng's dunk capped an 8-0 rally that put Minnesota in front, 44-42, midway through the second. Brandan Wright countered with a three-point play as Phoenix reclaimed the lead, and the margin reached 59-50 on a Dragic layup at the 2:11 mark. The Wolves scored the final six to get within three at halftime, and still trailed by just 76-72 after Mo Williams' 3-pointer with 3:33 left in the third period. However, a 10-3 finish to the quarter rebuilt the Suns' cushion to 11, and back-to-back treys from Green were followed by Wright's alley-oop dunk to give Phoenix its largest lead of the night at 102-86 with 6:38 to play. Eric Bledsoe finished with 16 points and Alex Len pulled in 12 rebounds for the Suns. Williams' 26 points led Minnesota while Andrew Wiggins added 17 and Thaddeus Young had 13 points, eight boards and six assists.

Previous Game: Tuesday, Jan. 13 – Minnesota 110, Indiana 101

Mo Williams erupted for a career-high and franchise-record 52 points, including 21 in the fourth quarter as the Timberwolves ended their 15-game losing streak by rallying for a 110-101 victory over Indiana on Tuesday night at Bankers Life Fieldhouse. Minnesota led 25-21 after one quarter, but Rodney Stuckey capped an 11-2 start to the second and the Pacers extended their lead to 52-46 by halftime. Indiana remained in front throughout the third period despite a 16-point performance from Williams, grabbing its largest lead of the night when David West made it 73-64 with 40 seconds left in the quarter. The Wolves pulled to within one early in the fourth following back-to-back 3-pointers from Williams and Robbie Hummel, and tied it on three separate occasions before Andrew Wiggins converted a three-point play to put Minnesota in front to stay at 93-90 with 4:29 left. The Pacers were still within three after West's jumper at the 1:40 mark, but another long-range strike from Williams doubled the margin and Thaddeus Young tacked on a key layup. Wiggins finished with 20 points for Minnesota while C.J. Miles' 22 points led the Pacers.

Hickson added 16 points and 11 rebounds for the Nuggets, while Gorgui Dieng led Minnesota with a career-high 22 points and 12 rebounds, and Andrew Wiggins chipped in 20 points.

On Dec. 19, Minnesota acquired guard Troy Daniels, two 2nd-round draft choices and cash considerations from Houston in a three-team transaction that saw Minnesota send forward Corey Brewer to the Rockets and center Ronny Turiaf to Philadelphia... To complete the trade, the 76ers conveyed guard Alexey Shved to Houston in exchange for Houston's 2nd-round pick in the 2015 NBA Draft and the rights to center Serhiy Lishchuk... Details on the 2nd-round selections heading to Minnesota are as follows: Sacramento's 2015 choice (protected for picks 50-60), previously acquired by the Rockets on Sept. 17, and Houston's own 2016 choice (protected for picks 31-45).

ROSTER NOTES: On Oct. 27, the Timberwolves announced their 15-man Opening Night roster, having reached the limit by waiving guard J.J. Barea... Anthony Bennett, Andrew Wiggins and Thaddeus Young were acquired in a three-team trade involving Cleveland and Philadelphia on Aug. 23... Three rookies are on the roster; Wiggins was chosen 1st overall by the Cavaliers in the 2014 NBA Draft, while Minnesota used its own selections to tab Zach LaVine (1st round, 13th overall) and Glenn Robinson III (2nd round, 40th overall)... Of the 15 players who finished 2013-14 on Minnesota's roster, seven remain this year... The current roster averages 3.1 years of NBA experience and has an average age of 25.1 years; last year's group was at 3.7 and 26.0, respectively (3.6 and 26.5 in 2012-13)... Mo Williams (32) and Kevin Martin (31) are the oldest Timberwolves players while LaVine (19) and Wiggins (19) are the youngest... Nikola Pekovic moves atop the seniority list, playing his fifth season in Minnesota, while Ricky Rubio is in year number four.

WIGGINS REPEATS AS TOP ROOKIE: On Jan. 5, Timberwolves forward Andrew Wiggins was named the NBA's Western Conference Rookie of the Month for December, his second straight monthly honor. Wiggins, the 1st overall pick in the 2014 NBA Draft, led all rookies in scoring (14.6 ppg) and minutes played (33.9 mpg) while ranking 2nd among Western Conference rookies in blocked shots (0.60 bpg), 3rd in rebounding (4.1 rpg), and 4th in steals (0.87 spg). He tallied 20+ points five times and was the Wolves' top scorer on four occasions, and tallied 20.0 ppg (50.8%) on the month-closing four-game road trip (Dec. 23-30). Wiggins posted his first double-double with 23 points and 10 rebounds in the Dec. 10 win vs. Portland, and netted a team-high 27 points at Cleveland on Dec. 23. Wiggins is the sixth rookie in franchise history to earn the monthly award, joining Stephon Marbury (January 1997), Randy Foye (December 2006), Kevin Love (March 2009), Ricky Rubio (January 2012) and Gorgui Dieng (March 2014).

WOLF TRACKS: Phoenix beat the Wolves for the second time in 10 days with Friday's 110-99 decision; the Suns notched a 113-111 victory on Jan. 7 at Target Center... Minnesota snapped its 15-game losing streak by beating Indiana, 110-101, on Tuesday, avenging a 100-96 home loss to the Pacers on Dec. 21 that was loss number five among the 15 in a row... The drought lasted 34 days, dating to the 90-82 home win vs. Portland on Dec. 10; it equaled the 5th-longest losing streak in franchise history and the 3rd-longest in the NBA this season... Prior to Tuesday's success, Minnesota had suffered 10 consecutive road losses since claiming a 120-119 victory at the Lakers on Nov. 28... San Antonio beat the Wolves for the third time this year with the 108-93 verdict on Jan. 10 at Target Center... Milwaukee completed a sweep of its two-game season set vs. Minnesota with a 98-84 decision on Jan. 9; the Bucks had posted a 103-86 win on Nov. 26 at Target Center... The Wolves completed a winless four-game homestand with the Jan. 7 loss to Phoenix... The homestand began with a 110-107 loss to Sacramento on Jan. 1 and continued with setbacks vs. Utah (101-89 on Jan. 3) and Denver (110-101 on Jan. 5); they've lost eight in a row (and 14 of 15) at Target Center, their longest drought since dropping eight straight to close 2011-12... Minnesota completed a four-game road swing with the Dec. 30 loss at Utah... The trip began in Cleveland on Dec. 23 (a 125-104 defeat) and included losses at Denver (106-102 on Dec. 26) and Golden State (110-97 on Dec. 27)... Minnesota ended its two-game East Coast swing with a 114-98 loss in Boston on Dec. 19; the trip began on Dec. 16 with a 109-95 loss at Washington...

SCHEDULE NOTES: Tonight's game wraps up the ninth of 19 sets of back-to-back games in 2014-15; the Wolves are 1-7 on the back ends (beating Detroit on Oct. 30)... Minnesota began January with its third four-game homestand of the year... Starting with Tuesday's win at Indiana, six of eight are on the road; the current four-game tour of the U.S. will cover nearly 5000 miles... The Jan. 10 loss to San Antonio ended a seven-game stretch (Dec. 30-Jan. 10) in which five of Minnesota's opponents were on the tail end of back-to-back sets; they catch a total of 25 teams in that scenario this year, including 20 at Target Center... The Dec. 30 outing at Utah began an 11-game, three-week run that sees the Wolves play seven sub-.500 teams; during the recent 15-game skid, nine of Minnesota's losses were to sub-.500 opponents... Minnesota finished December at 1-14; excluding the lockout-shortened 0-3 mark in 2011, it's their least successful December ever (1-13 in 1991, 1-12 in 1992)... The Dec. 23 loss at Cleveland finished a string of four in a row vs. Eastern teams (Dec. 16-23), a run that began at Washington and included games at Boston and vs. Indiana... The Dec. 6 loss in San Antonio ended a five-games-in-seven-nights slog for the Wolves, the first of four such stretches this year (Jan. 25-31, Mar. 13-19, Apr. 7-13)...

MARGINAL INFO: The Jan. 7 loss to Phoenix dropped the Wolves to 2-9 in two-possession games (decided by six points or fewer)... Last year, Minnesota went 8-15 in that category, winning six of its last nine after a 2-12 open... Half of the Wolves' last 22 games have ended with single-digit spreads, following an 11-game stretch (Nov. 8-Dec. 1) that saw 10 decided by 10+... San Antonio handed Minnesota a 121-92 defeat on Nov. 21 tying their 6th-biggest home loss of all-time... The Nov. 19 win over New York was Minnesota's first game at Target Center since Nov. 1 vs. Chicago... At 18 days, it's the longest in-season gap between true home games in club history; the six-game international sojourn featured more than 5600 air miles... Dallas dealt the Wolves a 131-117 loss on Nov. 15, one night after New Orleans walloped Minnesota, 139-91... The final 48-point spread in the latter game is the Wolves' largest losing margin of all-time; they'd suffered a 42-point loss (128-86) at Orlando on Nov. 3, 2010... Houston dealt Minnesota a 113-101 loss on Nov. 12 in México City; the Wolves began the extended trip with a 97-91 victory over Brooklyn on Nov. 5, their first road triumph of the year...

DOUBLE VISION: The Dec. 27 loss at Golden State marked the eighth straight game (one of 31 total) that Minnesota had fallen behind by 10+ points... On the flipside, the Wolves have fashioned double-figure leads in only six of 38 starts, most recently building a 13-point cushion in the Jan. 7 loss to Phoenix... The Wolves finished 26-for-26 from the FT line vs. San Antonio on Jan. 10, setting a club record for most FTs made without a miss, and followed up with an 18-for-19 performance (94.7%) in Tuesday's win at Indiana... Minnesota is 4th in FTAs per game (25.2) but 24th in FT accuracy (73.9%); however, they've risen to an NBA-best 84.1% (127-for-151) in January... The Wolves picked off 11 steals vs. Oklahoma City on Dec. 12, the fifth straight game they'd hit double digits in that category... Overall, they've swiped 10+ steals in 15 of their past 29 outings, the most recent occasion being an 11-steal effort in Tuesday's win at Indiana... The surge has catapulted the Wolves into 5th place in the NBA in steals (9.03 spg); they're also 7th in points off TOs (18.2 per game), 10th in fast-break points scored (14.5 ppg) and 6th in steal/TO ratio (0.60-to-1)... Three different Wolves players notched double-doubles in the Nov. 5 victory at Brooklyn: Nikola Pekovic (16 pts/11 reb), Young (12 pts/12 reb) and Ricky Rubio (14 pts/12 ast)...

THE BOARD REPORT: Denver racked up a 62-44 rebounding advantage on Dec. 26; the 62 total boards are the 5th-highest total ever by a Wolves opponent and the most since the Nuggets grabbed 64 in an OT game on Feb. 5, 2000 at the Pepsi Center... Minnesota has now faced double-digit deficits 10 times, including San Antonio's +19 (53-34) margin on Nov. 21 and the L.A. Clippers' +18 (50-32) spread on Dec. 1... In the last eight years, Minnesota is 7-95 when being outrebounded by 10+... Minnesota outboarded Portland 56-38 on Dec. 10, its second double-digit spread of the year (47-33 at Memphis, Oct. 29)... The Wolves have been outrebounded in each of their past three contests (by an average of -6.7 rpg) and 18 of the last 28 overall, after enjoying the advantage in eight of their first 10 games this season... The Wolves piled up a season-high 20 offensive rebounds vs. Portland on Dec. 10, helping lead to a 15-11 edge in 2nd-chance points... Minnesota ranks 2nd in the NBA in 2nd-chance points scored (15.6 ppg) and 5th in offensive rebounding pct (.277), but 21st in 2nd-chance points allowed (13.7 ppg) and just 29th in defensive rebounding pct (.720)...

OFF TARGET: Minnesota was held to 39.5% by San Antonio on Jan. 10, its seventh sub-40% outing of 2014-15... The Wolves shot a season-low 35.7% vs. Philadelphia on Dec. 3 and were limited to 36.4% by Golden State on Dec. 8... In addition, Minnesota's 77 points in the Sixers loss equal its low since scoring 72 vs. Milwaukee on Nov. 6, 2009... Minnesota shot a season-high 57.0% Nov. 28 at the Lakers, just the fourth time in the past seven seasons they've cleared 55% on the road... The Wolves' 37 assists at L.A. tie their highest total ever in a road game (Jan. 9, 2000 at Philadelphia)... Minnesota's previous best shooting night this year was a 50.0% effort at Dallas on Nov. 15; they're 4-10 when hitting 45%+ (2-22 when falling short)... The Wolves went 11-for-22 from long distance in the Nov. 19 triumph over New York, a season high for made treys... Minnesota has boosted its three-point accuracy to 36.4% (91-for-250) over the last 14 games, on the heels of a 10-game drought at 23.2% (26-for-112)... On the year, Minnesota ranks 26th in the NBA in FG accuracy (43.7%) and 20th in scoring (98.6 ppg), but last in both defensive FG percentage (49.7%) and scoring defense (108.2 ppg)...

AT THE OTHER END: The Wolves limited Portland to 38.8% shooting on Dec. 10, their best defensive percentage of the year; they kept Philadelphia to 39.0% on Dec. 3, and are 3-3 when holding the opposition below 45% (1-18 when allowing 50%+)... Minnesota has surrendered 50%+ accuracy in five of eight games to open January, the top percentage being Phoenix' 55.2% effort on Friday... For the season, Minnesota has allowed 50%+ a league-high 19 times (New York 14, Utah 13, Orlando 12); opponents shot 50% or better on 24 occasions a year ago... WOLF TRACKS: Minnesota ended 2013-14 with a 40-42 record, its best since finishing 44-38 in 2004-05; it's the fourth straight season the Wolves have improved on their previous year's victory total, having posted a 31-51 mark a year ago... Minnesota's season was highlighted by overtime victories at Dallas (123-122 on Mar. 19) and Miami (122-121 in double-OT on Apr. 4), as well as a late win at Golden State (121-120 on Jan. 24)... The Wolves finished 16-25 away from Target Center, their highest road victory total since going 20-21 in 2004-05... Minnesota has now missed the postseason in 10 straight seasons, after advancing to the playoffs every year from 1996-97 through 2003-04 (eight)... The current absence is the longest active postseason drought; Sacramento (eight) and Detroit (five) are next on that list... Minnesota's entire 2013-14 campaign was spent within four games of the .500 mark; they opened the season with three straight wins and were at 7-4 later in November, while the low-water mark came at 24-28 on Feb. 10... The Wolves put together three-game winning streaks on four occasions (Oct. 30-Nov. 3, Jan. 18-24, Feb. 12-22, Feb. 25-Mar. 3) with one four-game skid (Feb. 5-10)... Minnesota finished April with a 4-5 mark, but the four victories were against teams (Memphis, Miami, San Antonio, Houston) with a combined record of 220-108 (.671)... The Apr. 4 victory at Miami was the 800th in club history, while the Apr. 13 game at Sacramento marked the Wolves' 2000th regular-season contest... Minnesota capped a 4-1 West Coast swing with the 132-128 win at Denver on Mar. 3; it's the sixth time in franchise history they've won four games on a single trip, the first since December 2005...

MARGINAL INFORMATION: Minnesota recorded its franchise-record 12th 20-point victory with the Mar. 28 decision vs. Los Angeles; the Wolves also built leads of 30+ points in 13 of their 82 games, the top single-season total in the NBA since Utah had 14 such games in 1996-97... The 23-point defeat Mar. 20 at Houston represented the Wolves' largest of the season; they lost by 21 vs. Miami on Dec. 7... Minnesota's 88 points vs. New Orleans on Jan. 29 were the fewest they scored in a victory last year and marked just the second time they've won in the past 30 when tallying fewer than 90... The Wolves claimed a 121-120 victory at Golden State on Jan. 24 -- their first of the season in a game decided by four points or less, snapping a 14-game losing streak in that category; they finished 6-13 when the final margin was four or less, including 5-1 since Mar. 1... The Wolves won just three times a year ago when being held below 100 points (3-20 overall); the 98-72 victory over Utah on Jan. 18 halted an 18-game losing streak that dated to March 2013...

SCHEDULE NOTES: Minnesota dropped 10 of its final 16 starts (beginning with the Mar. 20 loss at Houston), after enjoying a six-week stretch at 10-4 that was highlighted by victories over Indiana (Feb. 19) and Dallas (Mar. 19)... The Wolves finished 4-17 on the tail ends of back-to-back sets last year, ending with an 11-game losing streak in that category... Minnesota went 17-13 vs. Eastern opponents, its first winning record against either conference since going 30-22 vs. the West in 2004-05... The Feb. 8 game vs. Portland finished the second of two four-games-in-five-nights grinds for Minnesota (also Nov. 19-23)... Starting with the Mar. 19 overtime win in Dallas, 12 of Minnesota's final 16 contests were against teams sporting winning records... Minnesota drew an SRO 19,888 on Dec. 7 vs. Miami, its lone sellout of 2013-14; the next-largest announced crowd was 18,065 vs. Oklahoma City on Jan. 4...
