### Last Game: Friday, Nov. 28 – Minnesota 120, L.A. Lakers 119

Zach LaVine scored a season-high 28 points and Thaddeus Young sank the tie-breaking free throw with 2.8 seconds to play as the Timberwolves rallied past Los Angeles, 120-119, on Friday night at Staples Center. Twelve points from Kobe Bryant helped stake the Lakers to a 30-23 lead after one quarter and the margin reached 10 on Wayne Ellington's 3-pointer early in the second. However, LaVine pumped in 18 points over the next seven minutes to pull Minnesota to within 58-54 by halftime and Young scored the Wolves' first six in the third quarter to tie it at 60-60. Minnesota pulled even five more times in the period but couldn't overtake Los Angeles until Robbie Hummel's 3-pointer made it 101-100 with 10:25 remaining in the fourth. Nick Young tallied 11 points during a 15-6 response that pushed the Lakers in front by eight, but back-to-back treys from Mo Williams squared it at 115-115. Young's go-ahead hook was answered by Bryant with 5.6 seconds left, and following Young's free throw, Bryant misfired at the buzzer. Williams netted 25 points and 11 assists for Minnesota while Bryant led the Lakers with 26 points and five steals.

### Previous Game: Wednesday, Nov. 26 – Milwaukee 103, Minnesota 86

Brandon Knight scored 13 of his 15 points in the last seven minutes, keying a 19-3 finish that carried Milwaukee to a 103-86 victory over the Timberwolves on Wednesday night at Target Center. The Bucks netted the game's first eight points, but Minnesota closed to within 26-24 after one quarter and edged ahead on a 3-pointer by Chase Budinger early in the second. Ten points in the period from Ersan Ilyasova helped Milwaukee reclaim a 51-47 edge by halftime. However, Corey Brewer's steal and dunk capped a 7-0 burst that gave the Wolves their largest lead of the night at 58-55 with 8:10 to play in the third quarter, and the advantage swapped hands five more times in the period, which ended with the Bucks on top 72-70. Larry Sanders' three-point play with 9:58 left put Milwaukee ahead to stay at 77-74, but Minnesota remained within 84-83 following a Brewer jumper three minutes later. Knight then started the game-ending flourish with a 3-pointer, and the Wolves misfired on nine of their final 10 shots. Sanders had 15 points and five blocks for the Bucks, while Brewer's 19 points led Minnesota and Wiggins added 14 with eight rebounds.

The Dec. 18 win ended a five-game series drought for Minnesota. The Wolves have lost 24 of 27 overall vs. Portland, following a 19-11 stretch.

First Meeting: Nikola Pekovic scored 30 points and Kevin Love added 29 points, 15 rebounds and a career-high nine assists as the Wolves downed Portland, 120-109, on Dec. 18 at Target Center. Kevin Martin finished with 22 points for Minnesota, while Damian Lillard topped the Blazers with 36 points, Nicolas Batum added 20 and LaMarcus Aldridge totaled 15 points and 14 rebounds.

Second Meeting: LaMarcus Aldridge scored 21 points and Mo Williams added 16 points and six assists as Portland turned back the Wolves, 115-104, on Jan. 25 at Moda Center. Kevin Martin poured in 30 points and Nikola Pekovic contributed 23 points and 11 boards for Minnesota.

Third Meeting: LaMarcus Aldridge scored 26 points and Wesley Matthews added 13 of his 21 points in the fourth quarter as Portland outlasted the Timberwolves, 117-110, on Feb. 8 at Target Center. Corey Brewer led Minnesota with 26 points, while Ricky Rubio finished with a career-high 25 points and nine assists, and Chase Budinger netted a season-high 19 points.

Fourth Meeting: Damian Lillard tallied 32 points and Thomas Robinson hauled in a career-high 18 rebounds as Portland overcame an 18-point, 2nd-quarter deficit to beat the Wolves, 108-97, on Feb. 23 at Moda Center. Kevin Love led Minnesota with 31 points and 10 boards, J.J. Barea netted a season-high 21 points and Ricky Rubio dealt 11 assists.

First Meeting: Blake Griffin tallied 25 points and 10 rebounds, and Chris Paul added 21 points and 11 assists as L.A. held on for a 109-107 victory on Nov. 11 at Staples Center. Kevin Martin led Minnesota with 30 points while Kevin Love contributed 23 points, 19 rebounds and seven assists.

Second Meeting: Chris Paul tallied 20 points and 11 assists -- scoring 16 points in the final 5:08 -- to lift Los Angeles to a 102-98 win on Nov. 20 at Target Center. Blake Griffin had 20 points and 10 rebounds for the Clippers, while Kevin Martin led Minnesota with 28 points and 10 rebounds.

Third Meeting: Chris Paul scored nine points in OT and added 13 assists as L.A. overcame a 45-point, 19-rebound effort from Kevin Love to edge the Wolves, 120-116, on Dec. 22 at Staples Center. Nikola Pekovic finished with a career-high 34 points and 14 rebounds for Minnesota.

Fourth Meeting: Darren Collison scored 16 of his season-high 28 points during a third-quarter blitz and DeAndre Jordan hauled down a career-high 24 rebounds as Los Angeles downed the Timberwolves, 114-104, on Mar. 31 at Target Center. Chris Paul had 22 points and nine assists for the Clippers, while Kevin Love led Minnesota with 20 points and 13 rebounds.

**ROSTER NOTES:** On Oct. 27, the Timberwolves announced their 15-man Opening Night roster, having reached the limit by waiving guard J.J. Barea... Previously, Minnesota had waived guard Brady Heslip (Oct. 25) and center Kyrlo Fesenko (Oct. 20), after starting training camp with an 18-player roster... Of the 15 players who finished 2013-14 on the Timberwolves roster, nine are back this year... Six new faces dot Minnesota's roster, including free-agent signee Mo Williams... Anthony Bennett, Andrew Wiggins and Thaddeus Young were acquired in a three-team trade involving Cleveland and Philadelphia on Aug. 23... Three rookies are on the roster; Wiggins was chosen 1st overall by the Cavaliers in the 2014 NBA Draft, while Minnesota used its own selections to tab Zach LaVine (1st round, 13th overall) and Glenn Robinson III (2nd round, 40th overall)... Last October, the Wolves returned nine of 15 players from their 2012-13 roster; they kept only seven of 15 players from 2011-12 to 2012-13... The current roster averages 4.0 years of NBA experience and has an average age of 25.6 years; last year's Opening Night group was at 3.7 and 26.0, respectively (3.6 and 26.5 in 2012-13)... Nikola Pekovic takes over atop the seniority list, beginning his fifth season in Minnesota; Ricky Rubio enters year number four...

**WOLF TRACKS:** Minnesota beat the Lakers for the fourth time in their past five meetings with Friday's 120-119 decision at Staples Center... Prior to that, Los Angeles had beaten the Wolves 22 consecutive times in the series (from Mar. 15, 2006 to Mar. 27, 2013)... Minnesota completed its four-game homestand with a 1-3 mark following Wednesday's 103-86 loss to Milwaukee, just the Bucks' third win at Target Center in the past 15 years... Sacramento handed Minnesota a 113-101 defeat on Nov. 22; one night earlier, San Antonio downed the Wolves, 121-92, tying their 6th-biggest home loss of all-time... Minnesota snapped its five-game losing streak with the 115-99 triumph over New York on Nov. 19... Dallas handed the Wolves a 131-117 loss on Nov. 15, one night after New Orleans walloped Minnesota, 139-91... The final 48-point spread in the latter game represents the Wolves' largest losing margin of all-time; they'd suffered a 42-point loss (128-86) at Orlando on Nov. 3, 2010... It also ties the 6th-largest spread in the NBA in the past decade, coming one night after Dallas' 53-point win (123-70) over Philadelphia... Houston dealt Minnesota a 113-101 loss on Nov. 12 in Mexico City; eight of the Wolves' last nine contests have been decided by 10+ points, after five straight single-digit finishes... Minnesota completed an 0-2 swing through Florida after suffering a 102-92 defeat on Nov. 8 in Miami, enabling the Heat to avenge a 122-121 double-OT loss last Apr. 4 at AmericanAirlines Arena... Orlando dealt the Wolves a 112-103 OT setback on Nov. 7, ringing up 18 points in the extra session to equal the 2nd-highest total allowed by Minnesota in an OT period (19 at Utah, Nov. 24, 1997; 18 at Dallas, Feb. 8, 1994)... The Wolves began the extended trip with a 97-91 victory over Brooklyn on Nov. 5, their first road triumph of the year... Chicago's last-second 106-105 victory on Nov. 1 at Target Center was the Wolves' third consecutive game decided by six points or fewer to open the season... A year ago, Minnesota finished 8-15 in that category, but won six of its final nine after a 2-12 open...

**FINDING THE RANGE:** The Wolves shot a season-high 57.0% Friday at the Lakers, just the fourth time in the past seven seasons they've cleared 55% on the road... Minnesota's 37 assists equal its highest total ever in a road game (Jan. 9, 2000 at Philadelphia)... The Wolves' previous best shooting night this year was a 50.0% effort at Dallas on Nov. 15; they're 3-2 when hitting 45%+ (1-8 when falling short)... Meanwhile, New Orleans shot a torrid 66.7% on Nov. 14, tying the highest FG percentage ever vs. Minnesota (Detroit also hit 66.7% on Nov. 8, 1994)... The Wolves have surrendered 50%+ accuracy six times in their last 10 starts, including the Lakers' 53.9% effort on Friday; they're permitting a combined 52.8% (and 115.2 ppg) in those 10 contests... Minnesota's best defensive effort to date came on Oct. 30, when Detroit was limited to 41.8%; Minnesota is 2-0 when keeping its foe below 45% but 2-10 when allowing 45%+... On the year, the Wolves rank 22nd in the NBA in FG accuracy (44.6%) but last in defensive FG percentage (51.0%)...

**DOUBLE VISION:** San Antonio outboarded Minnesota 53-34 on Nov. 21, the Wolves' largest deficit of the season... Over the last eight years (since Nov. 7, 2006), the Wolves are 7-88 when facing a double-digit board deficit (50-290 all-time)... Minnesota has come up short in each of the past four games (by an average of -10.0 rpg), after outrebounding eight of its first 10 opponents (+2.6 rpg)... Three different Wolves players notched double-doubles in the Nov. 5 victory at Brooklyn: Nikola Pekovic (16 pts/11 reb), Thaddeus Young (12 pts/12 reb) and Ricky Rubio (14 pts/12 ast)... Minnesota enjoyed six such games last season, most recently in the Apr. 11 win over Houston... Minnesota put together a 25-4 edge in 2nd-chance points at Miami on Nov. 8 (helped by a 17-6 margin on the offensive boards), they've held the upper hand in that category eight times in 14 games... Minnesota ranks 3rd in the NBA in 2nd-chance points scored (15.6 ppg), 2nd in offensive rebounding percentage (.286) and 4th in fast-break points scored (16.6 ppg)...

**WOLVES COMPLETE NORTH AMERICAN TOUR:** Friday's victory over the Lakers was just Minnesota's second outing in its past 10 (beginning Nov. 8 at Miami) vs. a sub-.500 opponent... Tonight's game kicks off the fifth of 19 sets of back-to-back games for the Wolves in 2014-15; they'll visit the L.A. Clippers on Monday... Minnesota played 21 back-to-back sets a year ago, going 4-17 on the tail ends of those pairs... The Nov. 21 loss to San Antonio dropped Minnesota to 0-5 vs. the Southwest Division this year; they split their 18 games with Southwest teams in 2013-14... The Nov. 19 victory over New York was the Wolves' first game at Target Center since Nov. 1 vs. Chicago... At 18 days, it's the longest in-season gap between true home games in club history; the six-game international sojourn featured more than 5600 air miles... Minnesota had a 17-day absence from Mar. 21-Apr. 7, 1998 while taking a seven-game trip... The Wolves are now in the midst of a four-week stretch (through Dec. 14) that sees them play 10 of 14 at Target Center...

**FOR OPENERS:** With the Oct. 30 victory over Detroit, the Wolves have now won 17 of their last 20 home openers, a stretch that began with the 93-92 triumph over the L.A. Lakers on Nov. 7, 1995; they're 18-8 all-time in that category... Flip Saunders remains unbeaten in 10 home openers on the Minnesota bench (the first nine from 1996 through 2004)... The Wolves began 2014-15 with a 105-101 loss in Memphis on Oct. 29, ending a run of 13 consecutive seasons in which they'd opened at Target Center (a string that began in 2001-02)... That's the second-longest home streak in NBA history, and the longest for any team in the same city and arena... The Hawks franchise began 16 consecutive NBA seasons at home (1949-50 through 1964-65) while moving from Tri-Cities to Milwaukee to St. Louis to Atlanta... The active leaders are now the L.A. Lakers, who opened at home for the ninth straight season on Oct. 28...

**WOLF TRACKS:** Minnesota ended 2013-14 with a 40-42 record, its best since finishing 44-38 in 2004-05; it's the fourth straight season the Wolves have improved on their previous year's victory total, having posted a 31-51 mark a year ago... Minnesota's season was highlighted by overtime victories at Dallas (123-122 on Mar. 19) and Miami (122-121 in double-OT on Apr. 4), as well as a late win at Golden State (121-120 on Jan. 24)... The Wolves finished 16-25 away from Target Center, their highest road victory total since going 20-21 in 2004-05... The current absence is the longest active postseason drought; Sacramento (eight) and Detroit (five) are next on that list... Minnesota's entire 2013-14 campaign was spent within four games of the .500 mark; they opened the season with three straight wins and were at 7-4 later in November, while the low-water mark came at 24-28 on Feb. 10... The Wolves put together three-game winning streaks on four occasions (Oct. 30-Nov. 3, Jan. 18-24, Feb. 12-22, Feb. 25-Mar. 3) with one four-game skid (Feb. 5-10)... Minnesota finished April with a 4-5 mark, but the four victories were against teams (Memphis, Miami, San Antonio, Houston) with a combined record of 220-108 (.671)...
