Last Game: Friday, Dec. 5 – Houston 114, Minnesota 112 (OT)

James Harden scored a season-high 38 points before fouling out, and Houston squandered a 13-point lead in the final five minutes of regulation before Nick Johnson's last-second layup in overtime gave the Rockets a 114-112 victory over Minnesota on Friday night at Target Center. Houston hit five 3-pointers in building a 33-24 lead after one quarter, but Zach LaVine capped a 19-5 rally that put the Wolves on top, 49-42. A late jumper by Chase Budinger sent Minnesota into halftime with a 57-55 lead before Harden had eight points during a 15-4 start to the third period for Houston. Jason Terry extended the Rockets' advantage to 96-83 with 5:26 to play in the fourth, only to see the Wolves respond by outscoring Houston 22-5 and grab a 105-101 lead on Andrew Wiggins' dunk with 58 seconds left. Donatas Motiejunas tallied the final four points of regulation and Budinger misfired at the buzzer to force OT. Minnesota tied it twice in the extra session, the last time coming on a Thaddeus Young hook with 15.9 seconds left that set the stage for Johnson's winner. Shabazz Muhammad's 20 points led seven double-figure scorers for the Wolves.

Previous Game: Wednesday, Dec. 3 – Philadelphia 85, Minnesota 77

Michael Carter-Williams totaled 20 points, nine rebounds and nine assists, and Philadelphia outscored the Timberwolves 12-2 over the final two minutes to halt its season-opening 17-game losing streak with an 85-77 triumph on Wednesday night at Target Center. The Sixers grabbed a 23-13 advantage after one quarter and took their biggest lead when Robert Covington made it 29-17 early in the second. However, Minnesota held Philly without a basket in the final 5:49 of the half and edged ahead 34-32 on Andrew Wiggins' steal and dunk in the closing seconds. Neither team led by more than four points in the second half until a Covington trey put the Sixers up 69-64 and K.J. McDaniels extended the lead to seven with 5:57 to play. Mo Williams' 3-pointer capped a 7-0 rally that gave Minnesota a 75-73 lead at the 2:17 mark, but McDaniels countered with a long-distance strike of his own to reclaim the lead and the Wolves came up empty on six of its final seven possessions. Covington finished with 17 points for the Sixers while Thaddeus Young's 16 points led Minnesota and Gorgui Dieng collected 15 points and a season-high 16 rebounds.

The Wolves' Jan. 24 win ended a seven-game slide vs. Golden State. Their most recent home win was a 126-123 decision on Feb. 27, 2011.

First Meeting: Klay Thompson scored 19 of his 30 points in the fourth quarter and David Lee added 22 points and 15 rebounds as Golden State pulled away to a 106-93 victory on Nov. 6 at Target Center. Andre Iguodala finished with 20 points for the Warriors. Kevin Love led Minnesota with 25 points, 16 rebounds and six assists, while Kevin Martin tallied 23 points and Corey Brewer had 18.

Second Meeting: Kevin Martin scored 26 points, including the game-winning jumper with 8.4 seconds to play, as the Timberwolves edged Golden State, 121-120, on Jan. 24 at Oracle Arena. Kevin Love collected 26 points, 14 rebounds and eight assists for Minnesota, with Nikola Pekovic adding 22 points and 14 boards. Stephen Curry topped the Warriors with 33 points and 15 assists.

Third Meeting: Stephen Curry totaled 32 points and 15 assists, and Golden State spotted the Wolves a 19-point advantage before rallying to win, 130-120, on Apr. 14 at Oracle Arena. David Lee finished with 25 points and Draymond Green added 20 points and 12 rebounds for Golden State, while Kevin Love led Minnesota with 40 points, 14 rebounds and nine assists.

ROSTER NOTES: Last Saturday (Nov. 29), Minnesota signed free-agent forward Jeff Adrien with a hardship exception granted by the NBA... The roster exception will expire when one of the Wolves' four injured players (Kevin Martin, Nikola Pekovic, Ricky Rubio, Ronny Turiaf) are cleared to return... On Oct. 27, the Timberwolves announced their 15-man Opening Night roster, having reached the limit by waiving guard J.J. Barea... Previously, Minnesota had waived guard Brady Heslip (Oct. 25) and center Kyrylo Fesenko (Oct. 20), after starting training camp with an 18-player roster... Of the 15 players who finished 2013-14 on the Timberwolves roster, nine are back this year... Six new faces dot Minnesota's roster, including free-agent signee Mo Williams... Anthony Bennett, Andrew Wiggins and Thaddeus Young were acquired in a three-team trade involving Cleveland and Philadelphia on Aug. 23... Three rookies are on the roster; Wiggins was chosen 1st overall by the Cavaliers in the 2014 NBA Draft, while Minnesota used its own selections to tab Zach LaVine (1st round, 13th overall) and Glenn Robinson III (2nd round, 40th overall)... Last October, the Wolves returned nine of 15 players from their 2012-13 roster; they kept only seven of 15 players from 2011-12 to 2012-13... The current roster averages 4.0 years of NBA experience and has an average age of 25.6 years; last year's Opening Night group was at 3.7 and 26.0, respectively (3.6 and 26.5 in 2012-13)... Pekovic takes over atop the seniority list, beginning his fifth season in Minnesota; Rubio enters year number four...

WIGGINS EARNS ROOKIE HONOR: On Wednesday (Dec. 3), Timberwolves forward Andrew Wiggins was named the NBA's Western Conference Rookie of the Month for games played in November. Wiggins, the top overall pick in the 2014 NBA Draft, led all Western Conference rookies in scoring (11.6 ppg), steals (1.13 spg) and minutes played (28.7 mpg) while ranking 2nd in blocks (0.47 bpg) and 3rd in rebounding (3.7 rpg), and shot 44.0% (11-for-25) from three-point range. He led Minnesota with a season-high 29 points Nov. 22 vs. Sacramento, tying the top single-game total by a Wolves rookie since Stephon Marbury scored 33 vs. Utah on Dec. 23, 1996. He also picked off four steals vs. the Kings, and registered season bests with eight rebounds, four assists and two blocks Nov. 26 vs. Milwaukee. Wiggins is the sixth rookie in franchise history to earn the monthly award, joining Marbury (January 1997), Randy Foye (December 2006), Kevin Love (March 2009), Ricky Rubio (January 2012) and Gorgui Dieng (March 2014).

WOLF TRACKS: Houston extended Minnesota's losing streak to four games with Friday's last-second, 114-112 OT decision... The loss is also the Wolves' fifth in a row at Target Center, their longest home drought since dropping eight in a row to close the 2011-12 season (Mar. 30-Apr. 26)... Philadelphia handed the Wolves an 85-77 loss on Wednesday; Minnesota's 77 points equal its low since scoring 72 vs. Milwaukee on Nov. 6, 2009... Minnesota completed a 1-2 West Coast trip with the 127-101 defeat at the L.A. Clippers on Dec. 1; the final 26-point spread marks Los Angeles' largest victory ever in the series... One night earlier, the Wolves dropped a 107-93 decision in Portland, their 17th defeat in the last 18 visits (dating to Feb. 3, 2006) to the Moda Center/Rose Garden... Minnesota beat the L.A. Lakers for the fourth time in their past five meetings with the 120-119 decision at Staples Center on Nov. 28... Prior to that, Los Angeles had beaten the Wolves 22 consecutive times in the series (from Mar. 15, 2006 to Mar. 27, 2013)... Minnesota completed its four-game homestand with a 1-3 mark following the 103-86 loss to Milwaukee on Nov. 26... Sacramento handed Minnesota a 113-101 defeat on Nov. 22; one night earlier, San Antonio downed the Wolves, 121-92, tying their 6th-biggest home loss of all-time... Minnesota snapped its five-game losing streak with the 115-99 triumph over New York on Nov. 19... Dallas dealt the Wolves a 131-117 loss on Nov. 15, one night after New Orleans walloped Minnesota, 139-91... The final 48-point spread in the latter game represents the Wolves' largest losing margin of all-time; they'd suffered a 42-point loss (128-86) at Orlando on Nov. 3, 2010...

WOLVES COMPLETE NORTH AMERICAN TOUR: Friday's loss to Houston dropped Minnesota to 0-6 vs. the Southwest Division this year... Tonight's game completes the sixth of 19 sets of back-to-back games for the Wolves in 2014-15; they're 1-4 on the back ends to date (beating Detroit on Oct. 30)... Minnesota played 21 back-to-back sets a year ago, going 4-17 on the tail ends of those pairs... Tonight also concludes a five-games-in-seven-nights slog for the Wolves, the first of four such stretches this year (Jan. 25-31, Mar. 13-19, Apr. 7-13)... Tonight's game is the lone road outing in a 12-day stretch that sees Minnesota play six of seven at Target Center... The Nov. 30 game at Portland began a seven-game run in which Minnesota's opponents (the Blazers twice, the Clippers, Philadelphia, Houston, San Antonio and Golden State) are a composite 89-42 (.679); excluding the Sixers, that jumps to 88-24 (.786)... The Nov. 19 victory over New York was the Wolves' first game at Target Center since Nov. 1 vs. Chicago... At 18 days, it's the longest in-season gap between true home games in club history; the six-game international sojourn featured more than 5600 air miles...

FINDING THE RANGE: The Wolves shot a season-high 57.0% Nov. 28 at the Lakers, just the fourth time in the past seven seasons they've cleared 55% on the road... Minnesota's 37 assists at L.A. equal its highest total ever in a road game (Jan. 9, 2000 at Philly)... The Wolves' previous best shooting night this year was a 50.0% effort at Dallas on Nov. 15; they're 3-3 when hitting 45%+ (1-10 when falling short)... Meanwhile, New Orleans shot 66.7% on Nov. 14, tying the highest FG percentage ever vs. Minnesota (Detroit also hit 66.7% on Nov. 8, 1994)... The Wolves have surrendered 50%+ accuracy seven times in their last 14 starts, most recently the Clippers' 51.3% effort on Dec. 1; they're permitting a combined 50.9% (and 113.2 ppg) in those 14 contests... Minnesota's best defensive effort to date came on Wednesday, when the Sixers were limited to 39.0%; Minnesota is 2-1 when keeping its foe below 45% but 2-13 when allowing 45%+... On the year, the Wolves rank 24th in the NBA in FG accuracy (44.0%) but last in defensive FG percentage (49.9%)...

DOUBLE VISION: San Antonio outboarded Minnesota 53-34 on Nov. 21, the Wolves' largest deficit of the season... The Clippers rang up a 50-32 advantage on Dec. 1; over the last eight years (since Nov. 7, 2006), the Wolves are 7-90 when facing a double-digit board deficit (50-292 all-time)... Minnesota has come up short in six of its past eight games (by an average of -8.4 rpg), after outrebounding eight of its first 10 opponents (+2.6 rpg)... Three different Wolves players notched double-doubles in the Nov. 5 win at Brooklyn: Nikola Pekovic (16 pts/11 reb), Thaddeus Young (12 pts/12 reb) and Ricky Rubio (14 pts/12 ast)... Minnesota enjoyed six such games last season, most recently in the Apr. 11 win over Houston... Minnesota put together a 25-4 edge in 2nd-chance points at Miami on Nov. 8 (helped by a 17-6 margin on the offensive boards), they've held the upper hand in that category 12 times... Minnesota ranks 4th in the NBA in 2nd-chance points scored (15.4 ppg), 7th in offensive rebounding pct (.269) and 4th in fast-break points scored (16.1 ppg)...

HOUSTON, HELLO: The Rockets dealt Minnesota a 113-101 loss on Nov. 12 in Mexico City; 10 of the Wolves' last 12 games have been decided by 10+ points, after five straight single-digit finishes... Minnesota completed an 0-2 swing through Florida after suffering a 102-92 defeat on Nov. 8 in Miami, enabling the Heat to avenge a 122-121 double-OT loss last Apr. 4 at AmericanAirlines Arena... Orlando dealt Minnesota a 112-103 OT setback on Nov. 7, the Wolves' seventh straight road loss in the series dating to a 102-101 win on Apr. 11, 2008... Orlando rang up 18 points in the extra session, tying the 2nd-highest total allowed by Minnesota in an OT period (19 at Utah, Nov. 24, 1997; 18 at Dallas, Feb. 8, 1994)... The Wolves began the extended trip with a 97-91 victory over Brooklyn on Nov. 5, their first road triumph of the year... Chicago's last-second 106-105 victory on Nov. 1 at Target Center was the Wolves' third straight game decided by six points or fewer... Last year, Minnesota went 8-15 in that category, winning six of its final nine after a 2-12 open...

WOLF TRACKS: Minnesota ended 2013-14 with a 40-42 record, its best since finishing 44-38 in 2004-05; it's the fourth straight season the Wolves have improved on their previous year's victory total, having posted a 31-51 mark a year ago... Minnesota's season was highlighted by overtime victories at Dallas (123-122 on Mar. 19) and Miami (122-121 in double-OT on Apr. 4), as well as a late win at Golden State (121-120 on Jan. 24)... The Wolves finished 16-25 away from Target Center, their highest road victory total since going 20-21 in 2004-05... Minnesota has now missed the postseason in 10 straight seasons, after advancing to the playoffs every year from 1996-97 through 2003-04 (eight)... The current absence is the longest active postseason drought; Sacramento (eight) and Detroit (five) are next on that list... Minnesota's entire 2013-14 campaign was spent within four games of the .500 mark; they opened the season with three straight wins and were at 7-4 later in November, while the low-water mark came at 24-28 on Feb. 10... The Wolves put together three-game winning streaks on four occasions (Oct. 30-Nov. 3, Jan. 18-24, Feb. 12-22, Feb. 25-Mar. 3) with one four-game skid (Feb. 5-10)... Minnesota finished April with a 4-5 mark, but the four victories were against teams (Memphis, Miami, San Antonio, Houston) with a combined record of 220-108 (.671)... The Apr. 4 victory at Miami was the 800th in club history, while the Apr. 13 game at Sacramento marked the Wolves' 2000th regular-season contest... Minnesota capped a 4-1 West Coast swing with the 132-128 win at Denver on Mar. 3; it's the sixth time in franchise history they've won four games on a single trip, the first since December 2005...

MARGINAL INFORMATION: Minnesota recorded its franchise-record 12th 20-point victory with the Mar. 28 decision vs. Los Angeles; the Wolves also built leads of 30+ points in 13 of their 82 games, the top single-season total in the NBA since Utah had 14 such games in 1996-97... The 23-point defeat Mar. 20 at Houston represented the Wolves' largest of the season; they lost by 21 vs. Miami on Dec. 7... Minnesota's 88 points vs. New Orleans on Jan. 29 were the fewest they scored in a victory last year and marked just the second time they've won in the past 30 when tallying fewer than 90... The Wolves claimed a 121-120 victory at Golden State on Jan. 24 -- their first of the season in a game decided by four points or less, snapping a 14-game losing streak in that category; they finished 6-13 when the final margin was four or less, including 5-1 since Mar. 1... The Wolves won just three times a year ago when being held below 100 points (3-20 overall); the 98-72 victory over Utah on Jan. 18 halted an 18-game losing streak that dated to March 2013...

SCHEDULE NOTES: Minnesota dropped 10 of its final 16 starts (beginning with the Mar. 20 loss at Houston), after enjoying a six-week stretch at 10-4 that was highlighted by victories over Indiana (Feb. 19) and Dallas (Mar. 19)... The Wolves finished 4-17 on the tail ends of back-to-back sets last year, ending with an 11-game losing streak in that category... Minnesota went 17-13 vs. Eastern opponents, its first winning record against either conference since going 30-22 vs. the West in 2004-05... The Feb. 8 game vs. Portland finished the second of two four-games-in-five-nights grinds for Minnesota (also Nov. 19-23)... Starting with the Mar. 19 overtime win in Dallas, 12 of Minnesota's final 16 contests were against teams sporting winning records... Minnesota drew an SRO 19,888 on Dec. 7 vs. Miami, its lone sellout of 2013-14; the next-largest announced crowd was 18,065 vs. Oklahoma City on Jan. 4...
